

Filed for naturalization & swore his oath of allegiance to the US on 27 Sep 1919. Joseph Wright reported he was a farmer living in Fishtrap WA. He was born 11 Dec 1888 in Hetton, Durham County, England. He had immigrated from Houghton, England, on 17 Oct 1906 aboard "Miriam" (which is listed as "Merion" on the ship manifest), arriving in Philadelphia PA on 29 Oct 1906. [Merion had arrived in Philadelphia PA on 5 Nov 1906.]

The form noted "Filed under Act of May 9th, 1918 as amended by Act of July 19, 1919." [This act conferred citizenship upon those who had fought in WWI for the US.] Joseph said he had resided in the US since 29 Oct 1906 & in Washingtons state since 6 Mar 1908 [which does not explain why he & his married sister were living in Illinois in 1910].
