



HILLSDALE—Mrs. Mary Wright was informed by Adjutant General McCain of Washington that her son, Leigh A. Wright, heretofore reported missing undoubtedly went down with the Tuscania. The young soldier, aged 19, was a member of the 100th aero squadron. He enlisted in the service at Adrian last August.

Explosion - Mrs. Gas Marv Wright a well known nurse of Hillsdale, is suffering from concussion of the brain, a broken nose and a burned hand, when she turned on the gas in an oven and forgot it until she tried to light it. Although the fire did not spread, the force of the explosion threw Mrs Wright entirely across the kitchen. Mrs. Wright is the mother of Leigh A. Wright, who was a Tuscania victim and after whom the local post of the American legion is named.


