





# Beaux Arts Ball Has History Dating To 1892

Many Santa Cruzans are looking forward with keen anticipation to the Art League's fourth annual Beaux Arts ball, to be Saturday evening in Coconnut Grove, with festivities starting at 9 o'clock with a Pageant of Nations and costume parade.

Some persons are asking "What is a Beaux Arts Ball and when did it originate?"

According to authorities on the subject, the "Bal des Quatres Arts" is a long-standing tradition that dates back to 1892, staged by the Paris School of Beaux Arts. The ball is named after the school's four arts: architecture, painting, sculpture and engraving.

Fashionable Parisians dressed to look like gods and goddesses of ancient Rome. Numerous legends are woven about the frolics of the eternal gods and goddesses when they departed from Olympus to mingle with mortals.

About 1 o'clock, the grand procession began and with eyes masked, the figures danced about with sky blue, chalk white, green and purple vying for supremacy, as a harrage of balloons cascaded above the merrymakers. The grand march of Aida was always played and prizes were awarded for best costumes. for best costumes. # LICENSE BARES 2ND MARRIAGE

The "secret" marriage last August of Mrs. Jenevieve Juanita Nedderman, 50, former policewoman, and widow of J. N. Nedderman, one-time Oakland police chief, was disclosed today when she applied for a marriage license in San Rafael to rewed her husband, Arthur E: Wassman.

Mrs. Nedderman became the wife of Wassman in Los Angeles seven months ago, but the discovery of a technicality in his divorce from his former wife led to their decision to marry a second time.

The Los Angeles ceremony was known only to a few intimate friends of the couple.

Wassman, 43, is supply manager at The Altenheim, an institution at 1720 Hopkins street.
