JOPLIN (Special) — Floyd Cecil Watkins, 78, of Joplin, was dead on arrival at Freeman Hospital here Sunday from what Jasper County Coroner Wendell Fuhr termed a self - inflicted shotgun wound.

The coroner said Watkins, found by a neighbor who heard the shot, had used a .12 gauge shotgun in the back yard of his home to shoot himself in the head.

A native of Oregon, Watkins had retired 13 years ago from Eagle - Picher, where he had been employed 31 years. He was a veteran of World War I.

Survivors include his wife, Opal; a stepson, Charles Kinney, San Diego; three daughters, Mrs. Leo Riley, Mrs. Ira Highley, and Mrs. Francis Bailey, all of Joplin; 11 grandchild.

JOPLIN (Special) — Funeral arrangements are incomplete for Floyd Cecil Watkins, 78, Joplin, who apparently shot himself in the head in the back yard of his home Sunday.

Jasper County Coroner Wendell Fuhr said the victim, who was dead on arrival at Freeman Hospital, evidently took his life with a 12 gauge shotgun.

An Oregon native, Watkins retired 13 years ago after 31 years of employment with Eagle - Picher Company. He was a World War I veteran.
