Life:

Salem, Or., June 26 .- One hundred and eighty accidents, three of which were fatal, were reported to the state industrial accident commission during the week. Of this total, 103 were subject to the workmen's compensation act, 46 were from public utility corporations and 31 were from other firms and corporations not under the compensation law. Railroad operations headed the list with 38 accidents, sawmills were second with 36, logging third with 26 and construction fourth with 17. William Cross, Marshfield, and Steve Sawuke, Clatskanie, were killed while logging, and A. E. Day, a trespesser, was killed by a train at St. Johns. Following is the complete list of accidents:

## SURVIVOR OF THE TUSCANIA

Is Nephew of Elmiran—Tells of the Wreck—He Is Yet Under Treatment in Glasgow Hospital.

Philip E. Wetmore of the Pacific Coast, a nephew of W. J. Wetmore of 374 West Fourth street, this city, was one of the passengers on the ocean steamer Tuscania, which was sunk by a German submarine off the coast of Great Britain a few weeks ago. He is yet in a Glasgow, Scotland, hospital, under care for pneumonia, contracted from the severe exposure following the wrecking of the vessel.

His experience in the sinking of the Tuscania is told by Mr. Wetmore in a letter from England.

"We were waiting for 6 o'clock tea. The ship seemed to rock to port and slowly began to list. She shivered like a broken pane of glass and then the lights went out. Soon they were on again. The engineer had hitched up an auxiliary dynamo.

"There was no panic. Every man knew his place. The ropes were rotten on some of the boats and they were wrecked in launching. Three destroyers came up and took the menoff. I went down a rope into the lifeboat, but when the next man tried it, it broke and he fell in upon us.

"Then we pulled away and were washed ashore on the rocks (at a point deleted by the censor). We were in the boat about five hours. Then we lay in the seaweed the rest of the night.


"There had been 20 men in our boat, but none of us knew how to handle it. She was dashed to pieces against the rocks and the waves washed us ashore. All but two of us were saved. About 9 o'clock next morning we found a farmhouse."

## Barbara A. Gilbert




Barbara A. Gilbert, 93, longtime Heppner resident, died Wednesday, February 19, 2014, at Eugene, Oregon. A graveside memorial service will be held Saturday, July 26, 2014, at 11 a.m. at the Heppner Masonic Cemetery. A potluck reception will follow from 1 to 5 p.m. at Cutsforth Park.

She was born September 21, 1920, at The Dalles, Oregon, the daughter of Philip and Minerva Roberts Wetmore. She was raised on Mt. Hood Flat and graduated from Mt. Hood Flat Grade School (a one-room schoolhouse). In 1939 she graduated from The Dalles High School.

In April of 1940 she married Don Heliker and moved to Ione, Oregon, raising a son Gene Heliker. The couple later divorced. She married Orville Cutsforth in December of 1951 and they moved to Lexington where they also raised Lisa Cutsforth and Donna Cutsforth. In 1964 the family moved to Heppner on property near the golf course. The couple did considerable travel in their airplane and motor home. She and Orville belonged to the Portland Flying Club, traveling to the East Coast, Cuba, Canada and Mexico. Orville preceded her in death in 1985.

On April 16, 1988, she married Eldon Gilbert at Heppner, a friend from her school days. They enjoyed traveling together in their motor home, going to Mexico, to Alaska and across the United States. He preceded her in death in 1998.




