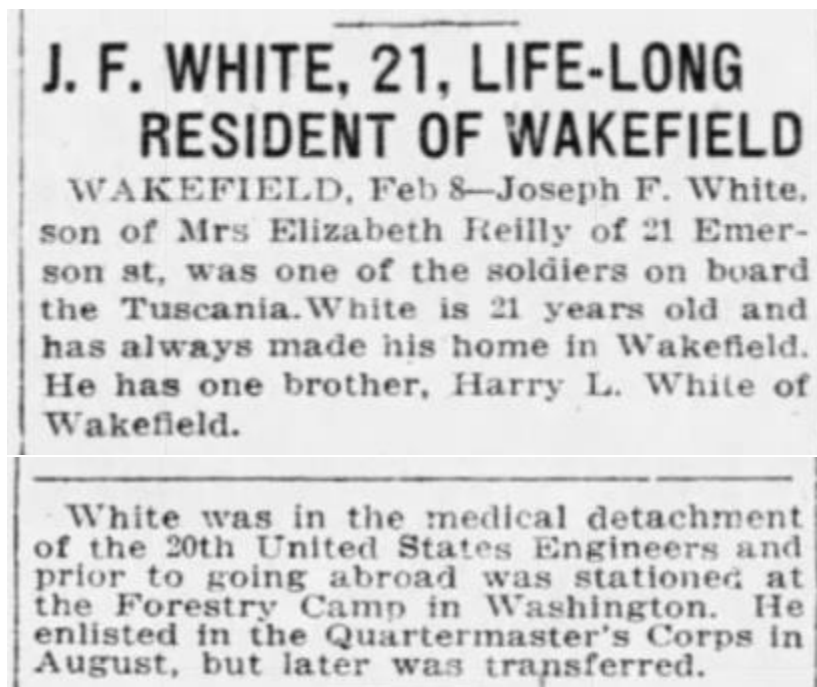

MAJORITY OF BAY STATE MEN SAVED

None Known Definitely to
Be Among Victims

Massachusetts Soldiers on List of Tuscania Survivors

News of the safety of a big majority of the Massachusetts men who were on the transport Tuscania when she received her death wound from a German torpedo off the coast of Ireland Tuesday, came yesterday in dispatches from Ireland and from the War Department.

Of the 29 Bay State men known to have been on the Tuscania, all have been listed as rescued with the exception of seven.

Four officers on board who claimed Massachusetts as their home were saved.

Lieut Richard Warren of Waltham cabled Mrs Warren of his safety Thursday, and Edward W. Borst of Newton Center reported his arrival in Ireland the same day.

EAST BOSTON DRIVER HELD FOR FATAL ACCIDENT

MALDEN, June 3—Joseph F. White, 27, of Eutaw st, East Boston, was held in \$1000 bonds for a hearing June 17 on a charge of manslaughter in connection with the death of Mrs Mary Magee in Wakefield Sunday night, and also charged with driving away from an accident without making his identity known. He had not obtained bonds up to noon when the court officers were ready to commit him to East Cambridge Jail.

White is said to have made a written statement to the police that he drove the auto that struck Mr and Mrs Andrew A. Magee on Main st, Wakefield Junction, fatally injuring the woman and causing serious injury to her husband. White claimed he got rattled after the accident and speeded away. The police were given two auto registration numbers and after investigation found the second number was for White's car. White formerly lived on Maple st, Wakefield.

Alfred appears to have worked for the Wakefield Rattan Co., based on information supplied when his children were born. This was the world’s leading manufacturer of rattan furniture & objects in the second half of the 19th century. Cyrus Wakefield had established it in South Reading (the town’s name being changed to Wakefield in his honor) in 1851. In the 1890s the firm merged with Heywood Brothers to become Heywood-Wakefield. It closed in 1931.

SAYS WIFE TOOK \$1000 HE HID IN CHIMNEY

Dyer of Plymouth Given Divorce, Naming Surette

Distrustful of banks, Edward W. Dyer of Plymouth drew \$1000 from his bank account and secreted it for safekeeping in the chimney of his home, only to have it discovered and appropriated by his wife when she left him on June 19, 1932. Dyer testified yesterday in Suffolk Probate Court. Judge Frederick J. Dillon granted him a divorce on the ground of infidelity.

The decree was entered after police, neighbors and friends had testified to seeing the wife, Mrs Mary T. Dyer, in the company of Harold Surette of Bartlett st, Reading.

Dyer, the first witness heard, said that he and his wife were married in January, 1932, and lived together in Boston and at Reading. He said he saw Surette at his home and also in the company of his wife in a restaurant where beer was sold. Speaking of Mrs Dyer's departure six months after their marriage, the hus-

band said: "Everything was gone, silverware, dishes, money, over \$1000 in the fireplace. Banks were failing and I thought it was safer in the house. She put it in the bank in Reading. I didn't receive any of it."

Chief of Police Thomas Crosswell of North Reading testified to raiding a camp in North Reading, in search of liquor. Inside, on the bed, he found a man who gave the name of Surette. Mrs Dyer was hiding in an alcove, it was testified.

The testimony given by Mrs Emma White of Nahant st, Wakefield, was to the effect that Surette and Mrs Dyer visited her home almost daily. One day, she said, she was busy when they entered. When she went looking for them in the kitchen they were not there, and she later found them in the bedroom. On another occasion when they visited her home, she said, Surette showed her shirts, stockings and a pair of trousers, exclaiming: "Look what Mrs Dyer bought me."

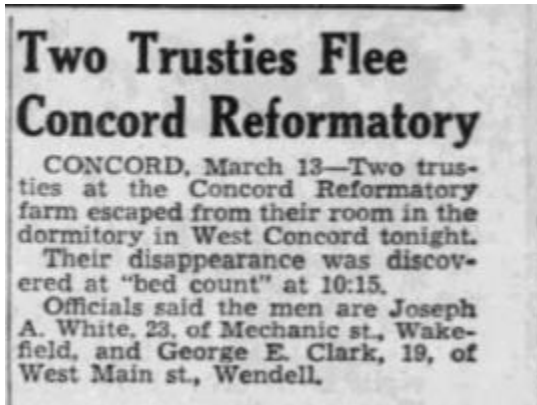

Prison and police officials requested authorities of Bedford Airport to ask civilian pilots to be on the alert for the men identified as Joseph A. White, 23, of Mechanic st., Wakefield, and George E. Clark, 19, of West Main st., Wendell.

The prisoners escaped by forcing window bars in their room and dropping 15 feet to the ground. Prison authorities said both have records as parole violators.

State Police at the Concord barracks said the men were trailed four miles through the

woods from the reformatory grounds to West Acton shortly after midnight, but the prisoners eluded police and prison guards.

Tanked Up Car Stolen

A West Acton man, Richard D. Powderly of Massachusetts av., reported to police early this morning that his 1940 sedan containing a full tank of gasoline was stolen from the yard of his home during the night. Police said the escapees might have been responsible for the theft.

Clark was serving a two-year sentence for using an automobile without authority, and White, a five-year term for breaking and entering and larceny. Both had been returned to the reformatory last August for violation of parole.

Reformatory Escapee Gets Added Sentences

A Concord State Reformatory escapee, Joseph A. White, 23, of Mechanics st., Wakefield, was today returned to the institution with two added "indeterminate sentences" to be served concurrently with his original sentence for breaking and entering in September, 1941.

Police told Judge Edward F. Hanify that White had been at large about a month. The sentences were imposed on fresh charges of escaping from the prison and of larceny of an automobile, despite White entering pleas of innocent to both counts.

WAKEFIELD BOYS ARRESTED

**Two Charged With Breaking Into the
Unoccupied House of the Late
William F. Greenough**

WAKEFIELD, Nov 1—Caught breaking into the unoccupied mansion of the late William F. Greenough, on Parker road, today, for the second time in a few hours, the Wakefield police arrested Harry L. White, aged 16, of 171 Albion st; Arnold F. Shaw, aged 15, of 24 Elm st, and John Reuben Deveau, aged 16, of 169 Albion st. The boys will appear in the Malden District Court tomorrow morning on a charge of breaking and entering private property.

Early this morning, the police say, the boys made their first attempt, forcing an entrance through a window of the first floor, but were frightened away by a woman living in the neighborhood.

Undiscouraged, the trio are said to have visited the house again late in the afternoon, this time entering through a cellar window. Chief of Police Pollard was notified by neighbors, and with patrolman Preston he captured Shaw and White soon after they left the house. Deveau was caught later by the police, acting on the story of the other two, but he denied his complicity.

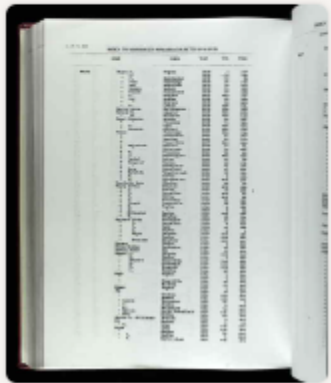

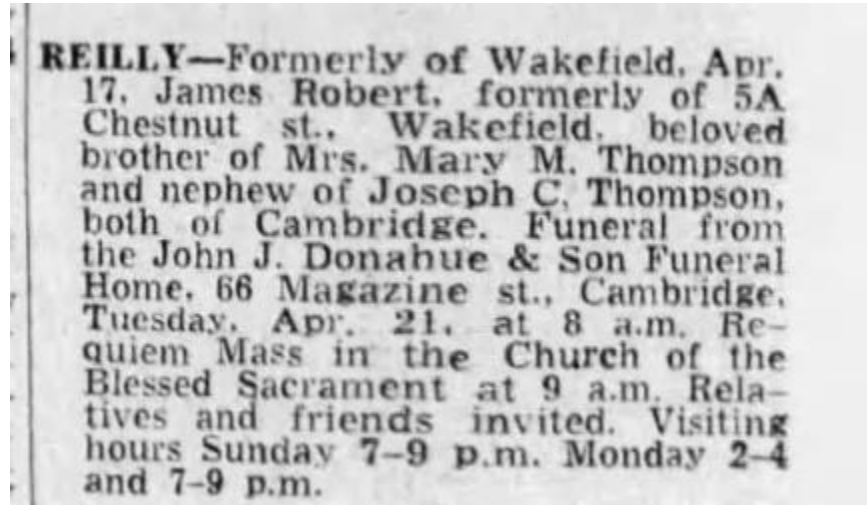

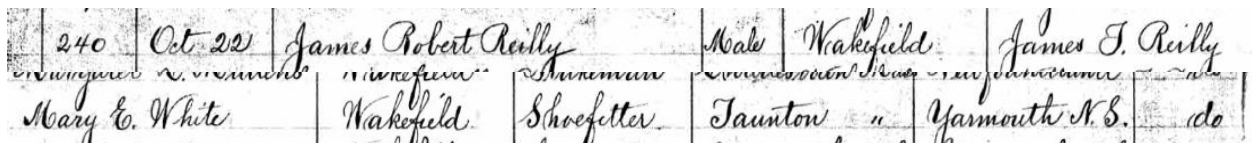
