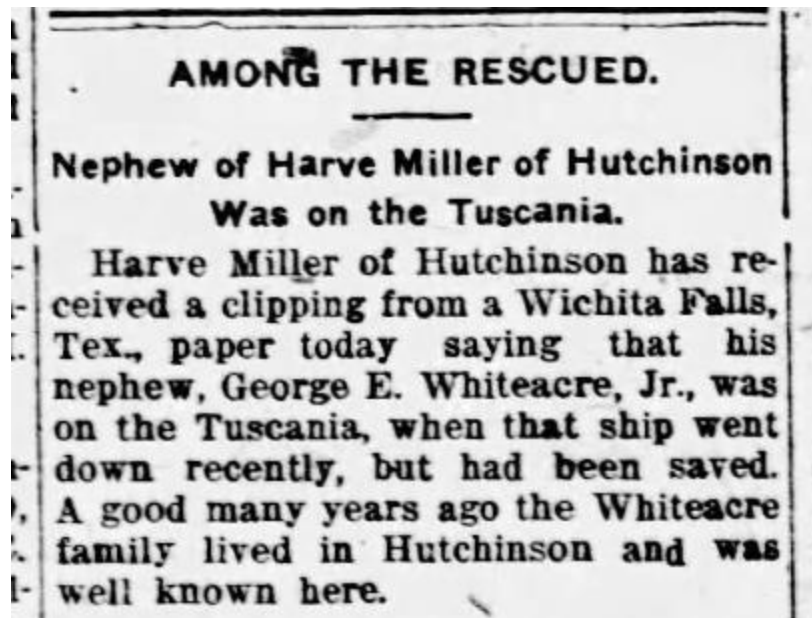

Visit in Murder Case Recounted

ROSWELL, Dec. 7 (P)—A woman witness in the murder trial of Arthur Johnson and his wife, Lucille, related today that the couple visited the apartment of William Cabrel in Hobbs the morning of the day they allegedly slew him.

The witness was Mrs. Geneva Gabbert, who lives at the same Hobbs apartment house which Cabrel occupied at the time he disappeared last March 5. His body was found March 19 in a shallow grave on a Texas ranch.

Mrs. Gabbert said that the Johnsons and their two children came to the Cabrel apartment and that she heard Mrs. Johnson say, "he still lives here."

Another dweller of the apartment, Mrs. Arnetta Whiteacre, testified that she heard noises in Cabrel's room the night of March 5. She described the sounds as those which would be made by the opening and closing of drawers.

The trial continued this morning after an overnight recess.

The Johnsons are charged with first degree murder.

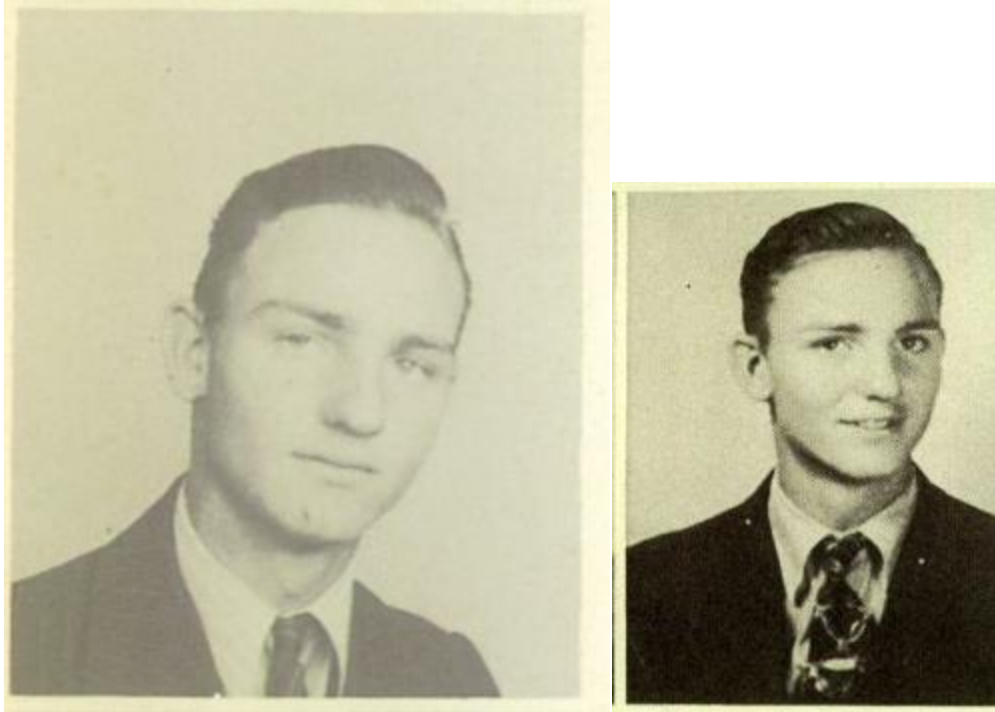
