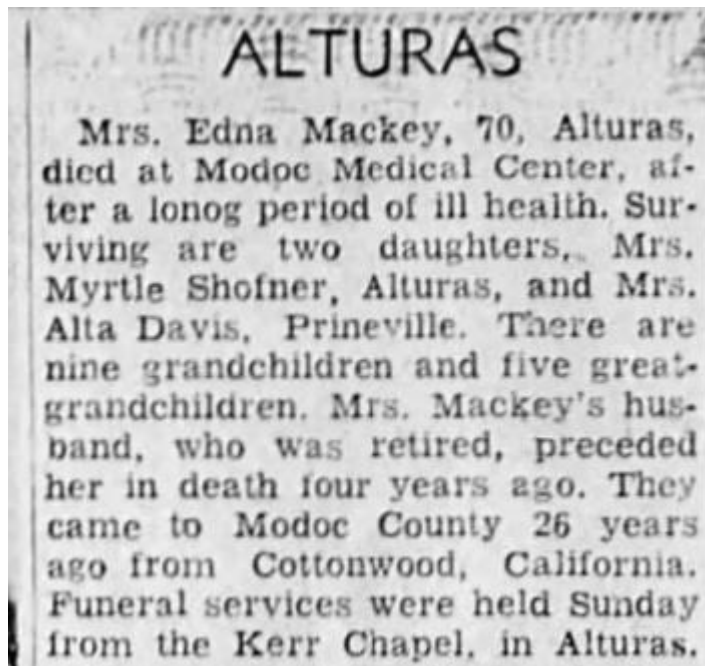

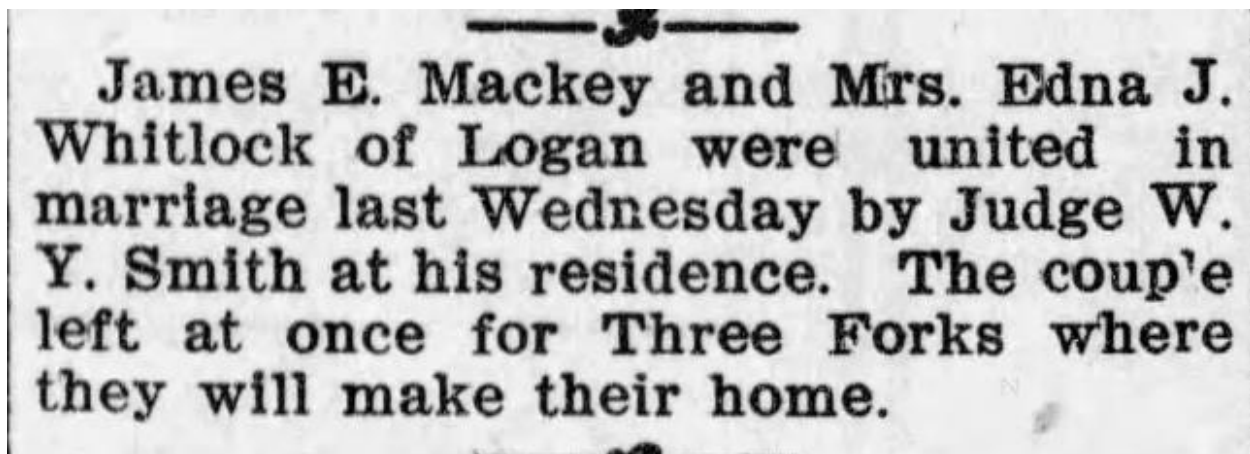

Alta Frances Davis, a long-time resident of Prineville, died Monday, Jan. 2, 1995 at her home in Prineville. She was 89-years-old.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 5, 1995 at the Heritage Chapel in the Prineville Funeral Home. Interment will follow in Juniper Haven Cemetery.

Visitation will be Wednesday, Jan. 4, 1995 from 4-8 p.m. at the funeral home.

Alta was born to Clyde Austin and Eden Jane (Kaylor) Whitlock in Wapinitia, Ore. on May 3, 1905. Alta's grandparents Lorenzo Whitlock and Rebecca Miller Whitlock came to Crook County in 1882, the year the county was formed. Her father was 4-years-old. The family homesteaded in the Post area. Tine Miller was her great-aunt and the first Pioneer Queen. Alta was quite a pioneer woman herself.

Otha Davis and Alta Whitlock were married in Bend on Aug. 17, 1925. They began their married life in a covered wagon. Two years later, they began a life of farming and ranching in eastern and central Oregon. Nine children were born by the time the family moved to Prineville in March of 1943.

The Davis' purchased the Ayres ranch on lower Crooked River, developed a Grade A dairy and later added a ranch in the Post area. The ranch on the lower Crooked River was

sold to the city of Prineville to develop the city lagoon in 1957. At that time, the family moved to Madras, where they had a dairy farm until 1963. They returned to Prineville, where Alta resided until the time of her death.

Her husband Otha preceded her in death in September of 1972. She was also preceded in death by an infant daughter, Margaret Jane Davis, and by her parents.

Her main hobbies were her family and her church.

She was a member of the Prineville Christian Church.

She is survived by: daughters June Pippin, Tigard, Ore., Betty Reynolds, Bonnie Hayes, Vera Harper, Donna Smalling, and Justita Strawn, all of Prineville; sons Clyde Davis, Kennewick, Wash., and Darrell Davis, Prineville; sister Myrtle Shiner of Alturas, Calif.; brother-in-law Albert Davis, Prineville; sister-in-law Marion Davis, Bellevue, Wash.; 18 grandchildren; 37 great-grandchildren; two great-great-grandchildren; and numerous nieces and nephews.

MRS. WHITLOCK ALLEGES ABUSE IN DIVORCE COMPLAINT.

The old story of shiftless habits, failure to provide, neglect and abuse, is told by Mrs. Mamie I. Whitlock of her husband, Cortis Whitlock, in a suit for divorce filed yesterday. Cruel and

inhuman treatment is the technical allegation.

The Whitlocks were wed at Wapinitia, Wasco county, Oregon, July 26, 1902, according to the complaint. They have five children as follows: Charles, aged 12; Mattie, aged 10; Nellie, aged 8; Ruby, aged 6, and Ralph, aged 3.

Mrs. Whitlock alleges that for two years past her husband has neglected and abused her and that whenever he obtained employment he squandered his earnings and gambled or frittered the money away. She says she was compelled to work out to support herself and the children. She asks for the care and custody of the children. W. B. Jones is her attorney.
