

WASHINGTON, Feb. 15.—The war department began receiving tonight the first official list of American soldiers who lost their lives on the Tuscania, sunk by a German submarine off the Irish coast.

Letter From Grayson Boy Who Was Lost on Tuscania

A letter from Walter Whittington, of Sherman, who was one of
the victims of the Tuscania, was
received by his pastor, Rev. P. L.
Pierce, a few weeks before he
embarked on the ill-fated ship.
The letter was read at the memoral service held at the Sherman
opera house in his honor recently. The letter is as follows:

To the Nazarene Church, Sherman, Texas:

Rev. P. L. Pierce, Pastor.

Dear Pastor and Beloved Church—I received your letter today; so glad to hear from you, and to know that the Church is praying for me.

You wanted me to tell you how I am getting on, spiritually. I can say this morning that I never felt more like going on in the service of the Lord, and doing all I can. I know that I shall be a better soldier for Jesus than I have ever been. I am going to be true and make Heaven my home, no matter what the cost may be. When I gave my heart to God I said goodby to the devil and all his works.

This is the hardest place I have ever been; so many of the boys are cursing and playing cards, it is hard to get them to stop long enough to talk to them. Thank God, He is keeping me through it all, and I am living as clean as when I was at home. I am so burdened for these lost boys. I am working day and night. I want you to pray for me that I may win them to the Lord.

I may soon have to cross the deep and go to France. If I do, you can say that you have one boy that will stand the test.

I am sorry that I can not be there to enjoy the services with you, but if I can't be with you in Sherman, I can meet you in heaven. I feel like my time is not far off, when I shall have "gone the last mile of my way." Well, thank God for this Old Time Way! Glory to His name! I love Him more and more. Pray for me; live pure and meet me in heaven.



Calling hours at the funeral home are after 4 p. m. Sunday.



Mrs. Lewis had been ill for about a year and relatives and friends had exhausted every effort to bring about her recovery.


