Washington, Friday morning, Feb. 8.—Five men from Florida were passengers on the transport Tuscania, which was sunk by a German submarine.

Of these the name of one appears on the list of the first twenty survivors reported to the war department.

Up to early this morning the war department had received the names of only twenty out of almost two thousand who survived.

The Floridians on the ill fated ship were:

Arnold Joerns, of 708 Biscayne Drive, Miami, private of the twentieth engineers.

Freddie Johns, Tampa, private 213th aero squadron.

Callan T. Albritton, Kyakka City, sergeant 213th aero squadron.

John T. Williams, Gardner, twentieth engineers.

Joseph H. Williams, Noma, private, twentieth engineers.

John T. Williams of Gardner is among those known to have been landed in Ireland.

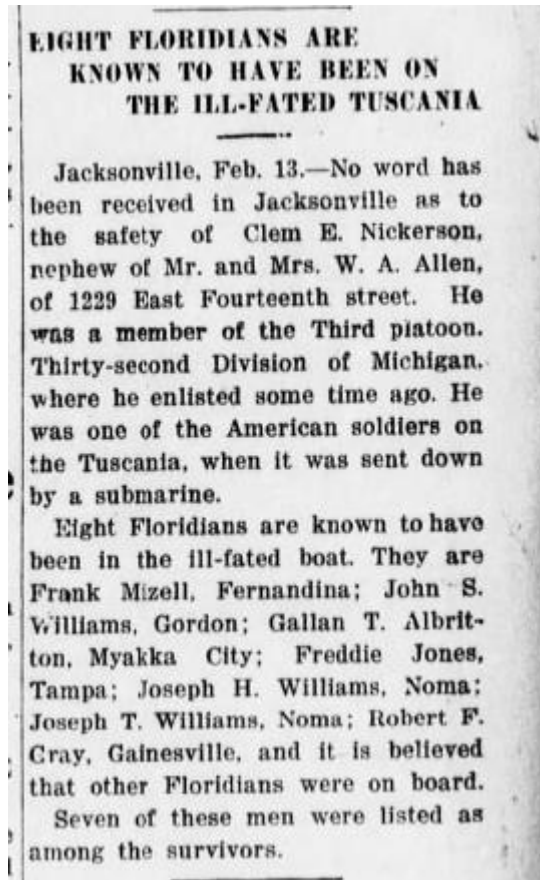

Associated Press dispatches to The Tribune last night from Washington stated that despite every effort of the government to secure lists of the survivors of the Tuscania catastrophe, and lists of the lost, the names were being secured but slowly.

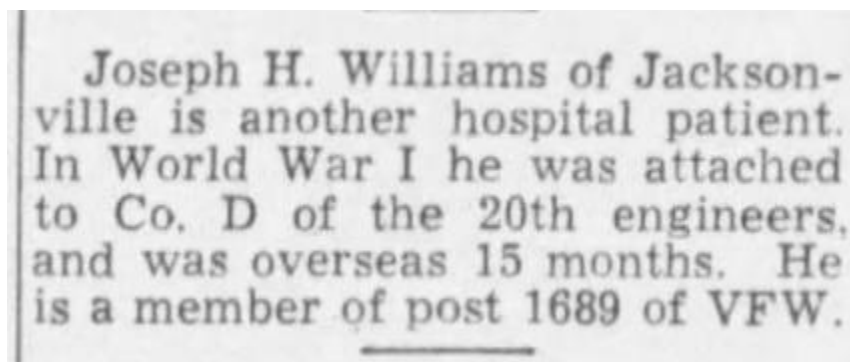
In the list received last night of the survivors are the names of five Floridians—one of them being Freddie Johns of Tampa. Young Johns is the son of Mr. and Mrs. B. K. Johns of No. 2812 Morgan street. Mr. and Mrs. Johns had no previous intimation that their son was on the Tuscania, although they supposed him to be on his way to Europe.

The other Floridians reported saved are Gallan Albritton of Myakka City and John S. Williams of Gardner, Joseph H. Williams of Noma, and Robert F. Gray of Gainesville.


