MIAMIAN WAS **ON TUSCANIA** Arnold Joerns, 708 Biscayne Drive, Private Of 20th Engineers; Fate Unknown. (Special to The Herald.) Washington, Friday morning, Feb. 8.-Five men from Florida were passengers on the transport Tuscania, which was sunk by a German submarine. Of these the name of one appears on the list of the first twenty survivors reported to the war department. Up to early this morning the war department had received the names of only twenty out of almost two thousand who survived. The Floridians on the ill fated ship were: Arnold Joerns, of 708 Biscayne Drive, Miami, private of the twentieth engineers. Freddie Johns, Tampa, private 213th aero squadron. Callan T. Albritton, Kyakka City. sergeant 213th aero squadron. John T. Williams, Gardner, twentieth engineers Joseph H. Williams, Noma, private, twentieth engineers. John T. Williams of Gardner is among those known to have been landed in Ireland.

Associated Press dispatches to The Tribune last night from Washington stated that despite every effort of the government to secure lists of the survivors of the Tuscania catastrophe, and lists of the lost, the names were being secured but slowly.

In the list received last night of the survivors are the names of five Floridians—one of them being Freddle Johns of Tampa. Young Johns is the son of Mr. and Mrs. B. K. Johns of No. 2812 Morgan street. Mr. and Mrs. Johns had no previous intimation that their son was on the Tuscania, although they supposed him to be on his way to Europe.

EIGHT FLORIDIANS ARE KNOWN TO HAVE BEEN ON THE ILL-FATED TUSCANIA


Jacksonville, Feb. 13 .- No word has been received in Jacksonville as to the safety of Clem E. Nickerson, nephew of Mr. and Mrs. W. A. Allen, of 1229 East Fourteenth street. He was a member of the Third platoon. Thirty-second Division of Michigan. where he enlisted some time ago. He was one of the American soldiers on the Tuscania, when it was sent down by a submarine.

Eight Floridians are known to have been in the ill-fated boat. They are Frank Mizell, Fernandina; John S. Williams, Gordon; Gallan T. Albritton, Myakka City; Freddie Jones, Tampa; Joseph H. Williams, Noma; Joseph T. Williams, Noma; Robert F. Cray, Gainesville, and it is believed that other Floridians were on board. Seven of these men were listed as among the survivors.
