

It was established by an official announcement issued by the War Department at Washington that Roy Muncaster, a Denver boy, son of Mrs. Elizabeth Muncaster, Paul A. Williams, son of J. N. Williams, Pueblo, were on board the Cunard liner Tuscania when it was torpedoed off the north coast of Ireland. In addition to definitely establishing the fact that Muncaster and Williams were on the Tuscania, their names appear in an official list given out by the government of those whose names do not appear on the list of soldiers rescued and accounted for.




