WAS IN AVIATION SECTION OF ARMY

At least one New Castle boy is known positively to have been on the ill-fated Tuscania, which was sunk by a submarine off the coast of Ireland. He is D. G. Young, son of Mr. and Mrs. W. G. Young of 101½ North Liberty street. His name is in the list of Western Pennsylvania boys on the boat. Whether he was among the survivors is not yet known.

The young man enlisted on Nov. 5th at the local recruiting station for service in the aviation corps of the United States army. He was sent from this city to the Columbus, O., barracks. Where he spent his training period is not known but it is supposed that like most of the men sent from here, he was sent to Kelley field, near Fort Sam Houston, Texas, to train.

He was born at Grove City, September 2, 1899 at Grove City and was aged 18 years and two months when he enlisted. He gave his occupation as that of a laborer in enlisting and mentioned his mother, Mrs. Maude Young, as his next of kin.

- Zabel Yacoobian Magarian, ca. 1885 Armenia – Wife of Karekin/Karakin Magarian, an Armenian/Turkish rug dealer in Detroit MI for decades. Karekin Magarian d. 12 Nov 1957 in Detroit, Wayne MI, age 78 ("Detroit Free Press" 14 Nov 1957 p 29). Karekin's obituary does not list his wife as a survivor. Lists sons Hodge, Aram & Arvid & daughter Mrs. Harry Nevers (believe this is Sybil Magarian, 1914-1990). Karekin Magarian (1879 Turkey – 1957 MI) is buried Evergreen Cemetery, Detroit, Wayne MI, F: 233992111. – Zabel & Karekin live in Detroit, Wayne MI in the 1920, 1930, 1940 & 1950 censuses. In 1920, they live on Canton Avenue. In 1930 they live on Welland Avenue. In 1940 & 1950, they live at 18255 Northlawn. Zabel is listed in the 1950 census, age 66, b. Turkey, conducted 6 Apr 1950 but not in her husband's Nov 1957 obituary.
