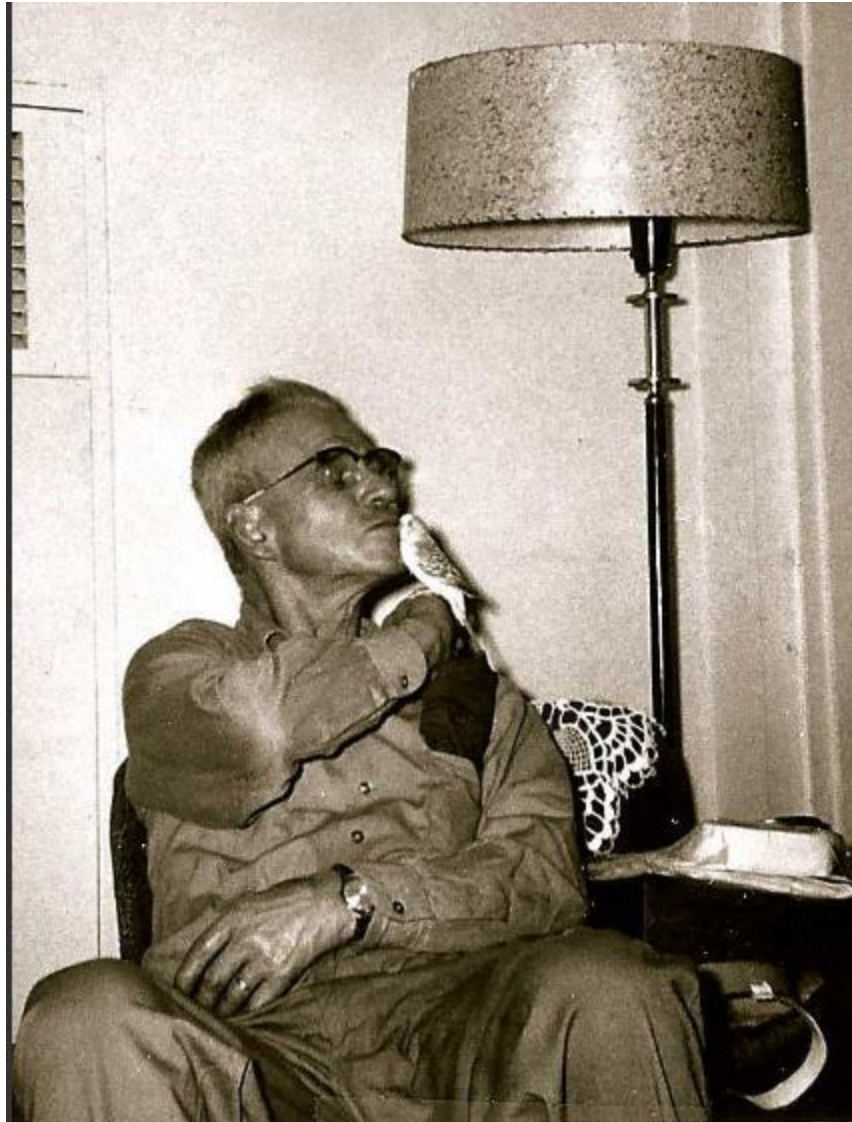

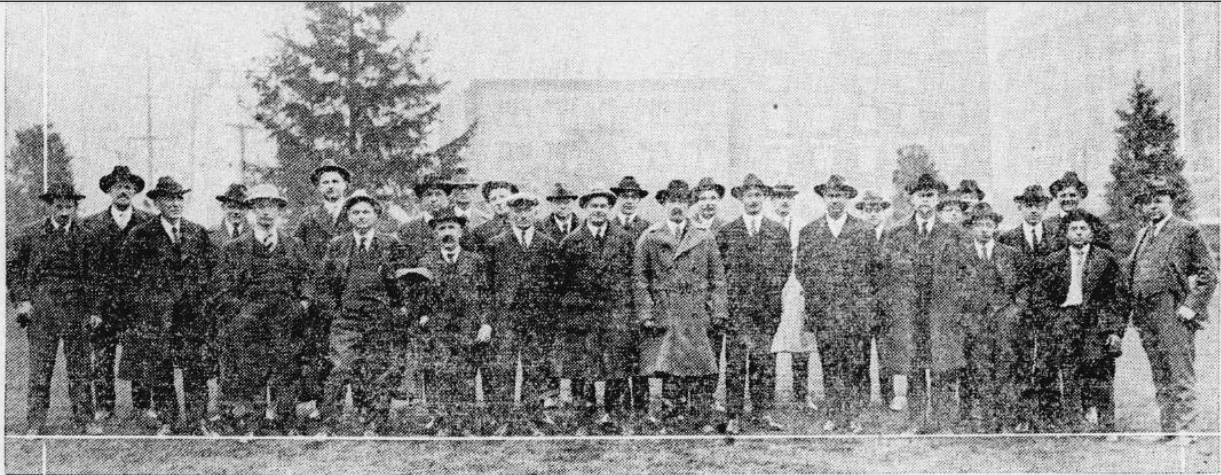

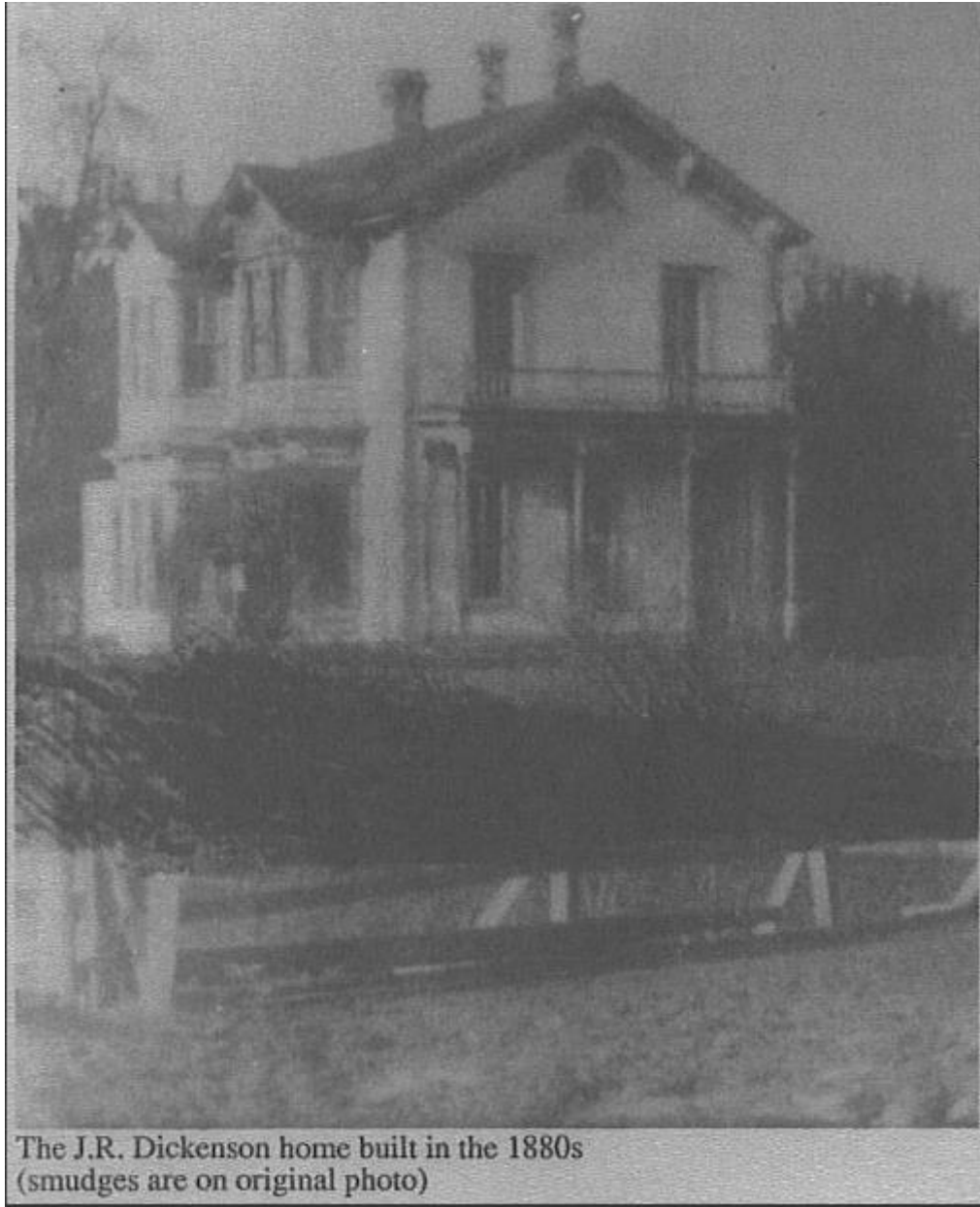

She was a passionate gardener, having started the "Country Cousins" garden club, a member of the Rose Society, and a WSU Master Gardener.

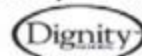
