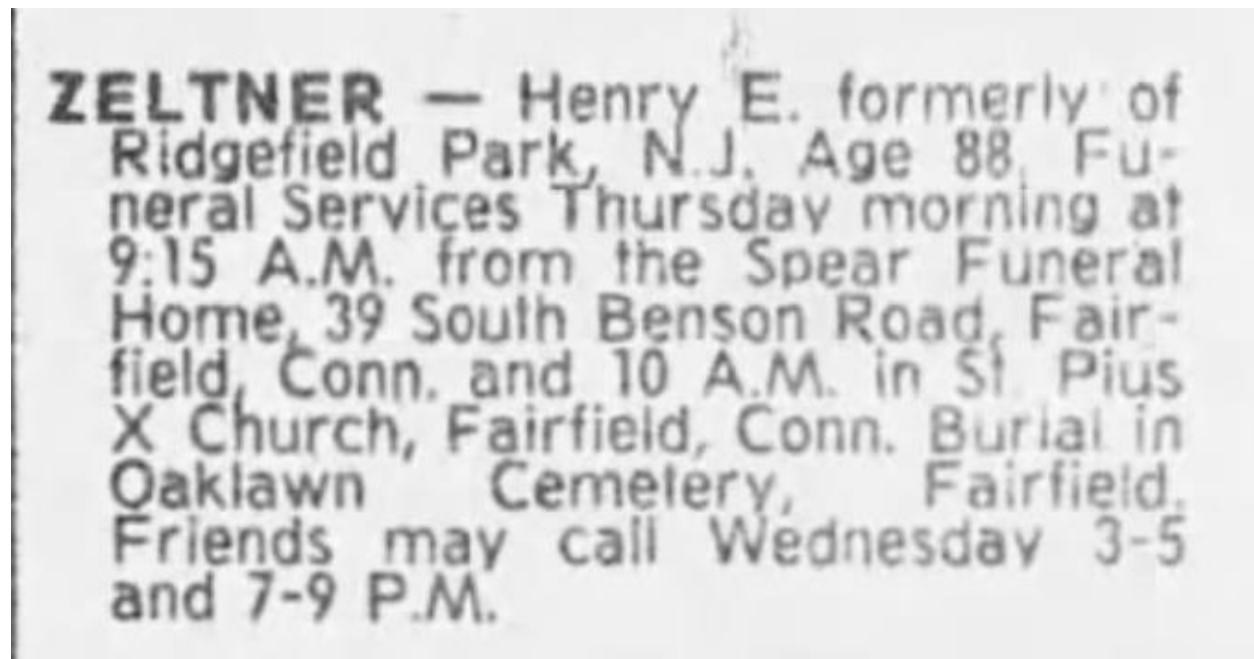

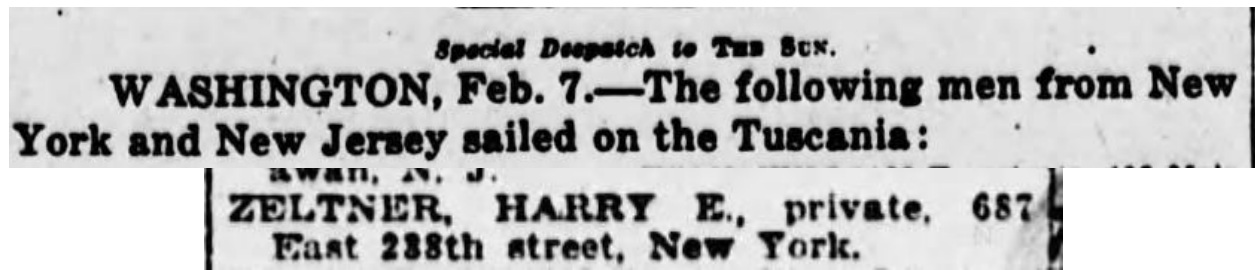
Large Class Graduated From P. S. No.

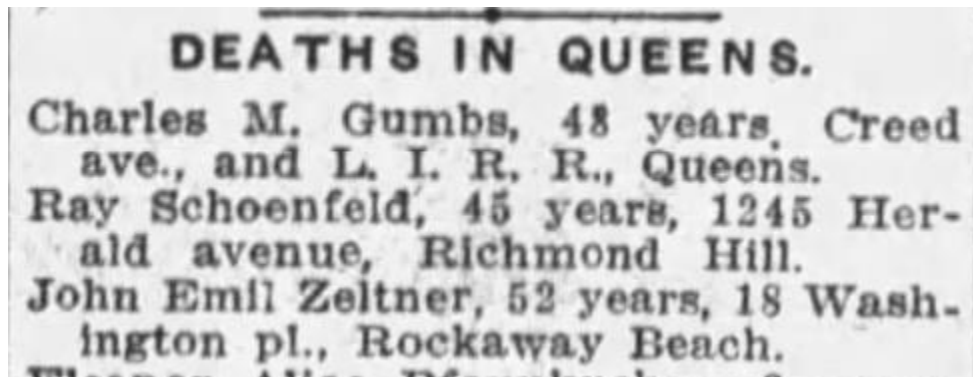

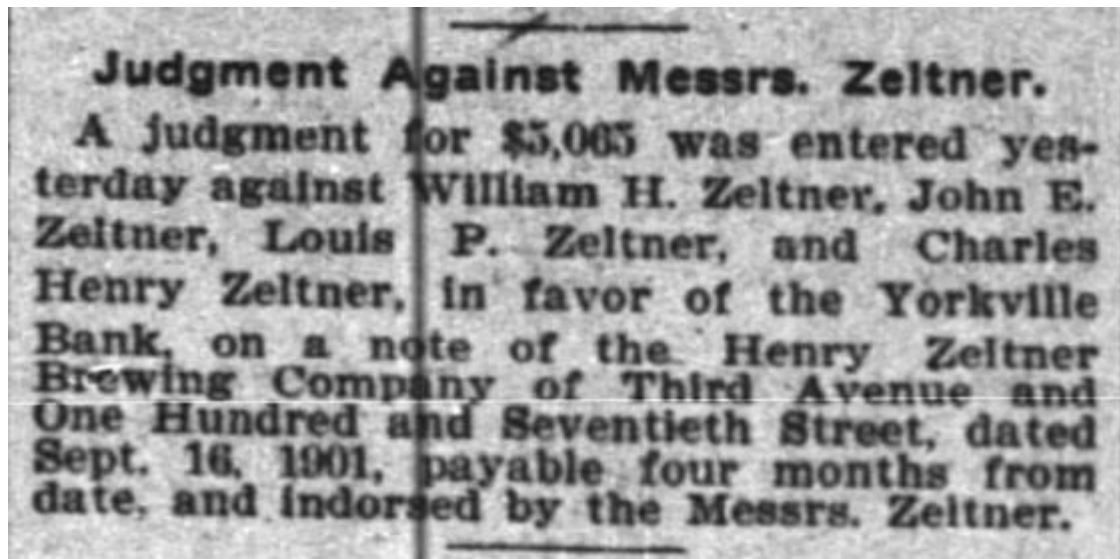

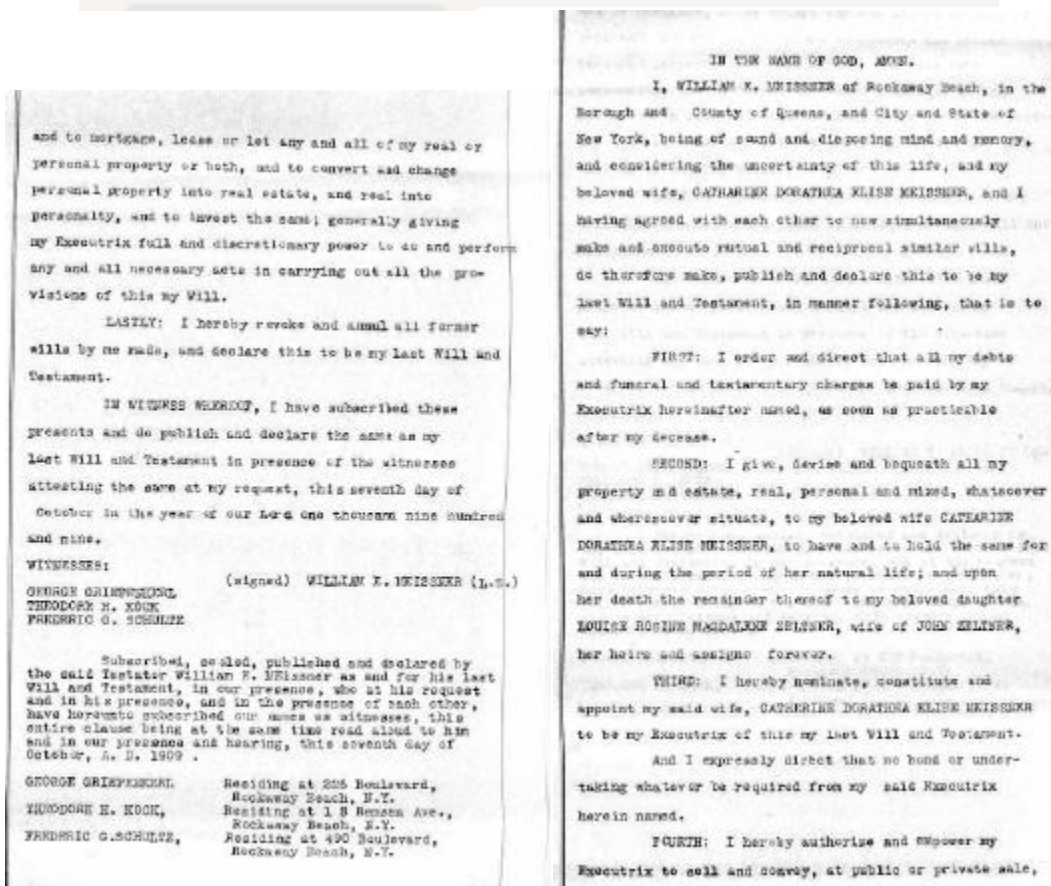

Rockaway Man and Wife Made Simultaneous Reciprocal Wills.

JAMAICA, March 22.—An estate valued at close to \$100,000 is disposed of by the will of William E. Meissner, late of 1 South Remsen avenue, Rockaway Beach, which was filed for probate yesterday in the Surrogate's office. The value as stated in the accompanying affidavit is \$67,000 in real and \$30,000 in personal property. The will was executed on October 7, 1909. Meissner died on March 18 last. He is survived by a widow, Catharina, and a daughter, Louise R. M. Zeltner, both of 1 South Remsen avenue.

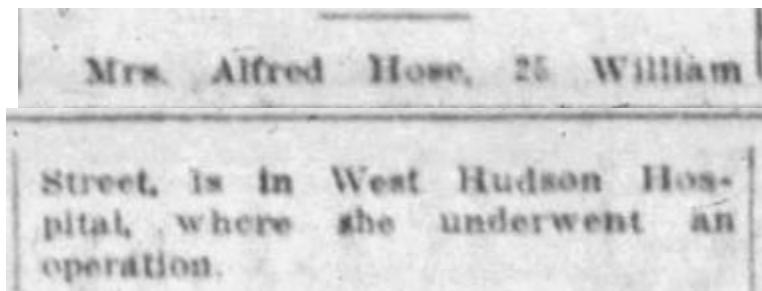
