FIREBOSS DIES IN MINE

Walks Into Gas Pocket in Pacific Coast Coal Company Property at Burnett

Joe Zeman, 39, fire boss for the Pacific Coast Coal Company at Burnett, 25 miles southeast of Tacoma, was found dead from asphyxiation in the mine early Tuesday morning by other employes.

It is not known just how Zeman met death, but it is supposed that in making his way through the mines on an inspection trip, he was his custom, he walked into a gas pocket, was overcome and succumber before any one could help him.

Zeman had been married by 10 days, his wife being Hazel Sample, daughter of J. A. Mitchell, 143 South 1st street, Tacoma. Mrs. Zeman lives at Tacoma at the time of the tragedy. Tuesday morning the body was found by the employes at the latter place after the mine had been notified.

William C. Botting, state mine inspector, and other employes of the company, including C. Botting, went down into the mine shortly before noon to make an inspection and an investigation. After a short investigation, the employes having decided that death was accidental and it would not be necessary for him to conduct an investigation.

Zeman, who is an ex-service man, formerly lived in Aberdeen. He had been employed at the mines at Burnett for a long time and was in the habit of making his way about the mines by himself on his inspection trips and for that reason his absence was not noted by the employes in the mine for a long time, it was said.

About 2:30 o'clock Tuesday morning fellow employes at the mine set out to look for him and to find him in the gas pocket. The body was recovered without difficulty.
