ADRIAN, Ore. — Services for Adolph B. "Rudie" Zimmerman, 91, Adrian, who died Saturday in a Boise hospital, will be conducted at 2 p.m. today in Nyssa Lienkaemper Chapel by the Rev. Fred Moxom of the Owyhee Community Church. Cremation will follow in Cloverdale Crematorium, Boise.

He was born Jan. 30, 1889, in Metz, Mich., to John and Augusta Zimmerman. He moved to Oregon at the age of 17. He joined the Army in 1906, and served in Europe during World War I. He moved to the Adrian area more than 35 years ago and worked at Adrian Supply until his retirement.

Survivors include three nephews and a cousin.
