FUNERAL SATURDAY FOR WORLD WAR VETERAN

Anthony Burzykowski Was Aboard
Tuscania When It Sank; V. F. W.
to Fire Salute at Grave

Funeral services for Anthony Burzykowski, 46, who died at St. Lawrence hospital Thursday morning, will be held from the Palmer-O'Donnell Funeral home Saturday morning at 9 o'clock. Interment will be in Deepdale cemetery.

Mr. Burzykowski was a member of the Veterans of Foreign Wars and also of Lansing Lodge of Elks, No. 196. The firing squad of the local V. F. W. post will fire a salute and the bugle corps will sound taps at the grave.

Mr. Burzykowski was an aviation mechanic during the World war and was aboard the Tuscania when it was sunk in the Irish sea. He is survived by a brother and sister in Poland.

MI death certificate: Died in St. Lawrence Hospital, Lansing, Ingham MI. Single. Date of birth unknown – age 46. Tinsmith. Died 14 Feb 1929 of a brain tumor with intracranial hemorrhage. Attended by Dr. C. Kenneth Miller from 20 Jan 1929 to the day before his death (13 Feb 1929). Born in Warsaw, Poland. Father: Phillip Burzykowski, b. Poland. Mother's name unknown, b. Warsaw, Poland. Autopsy performed. Informant: Anthony Czaczkowski, 600 Amesbury (spelling?) St., Lansing MI. Buried in Deepdale Cemetery on 16 Feb 1929. Unknown if he had a spouse, or her name.
