Transferred to Motor Truck Co. No. 1, 107th Supply Train, 32nd Div. Sailed in January, 1918, on the Tuscania. Promoted to Corporal. Fought at Chateau Thierry, the Argonne Forest and St. Mihiel. In Germany with Army of Occupation. Returned to the U. S. and was mustered out May 29, 1919.

Michael J. Cosgrove, 71, of 421 Poplar St., City, passed away at St. Joseph's Hospital on April 28, after a lingering illness.

He was born September 26, 1897, in Chippewa Falls, the son of Bernard and Ellen Murray Cosgrove. On August 4, 1921, he was united in marriage to Catherine Gelina at St. Charles Church, Chippewa Falls.

Mr. Cosgrove was a member of Notre Dame Parish, World War I Barracks, and the American Legion Post of Chippewa Falls. He attended Notre Dame School and entered the service in February of 1917. After receiving his training he was transported to the European theater of operation, having sailed on the Tuscania in January of 1918. He was discharged on May 29, 1919. After re-listing for a period of one year and being relieved of his duties he was employed by the Vaudreuil Lumber Company. He was then employed as a carpenter in Minneapolis for a number of years and later moved to the State of Oregon

where he was employed in the building industry. He was employed as a heavy equipment operator during the construction of the Alkan Highway and returned to Chippewa Falls at the time of his retirement in 1957.

With the arrival of 28 members of the 107th Supply Train Friday morning this winds up the landing of the entire 32nd Division after from 12 to 15 months of overseas service. These lads show the results of U. S. Army training for they are all pictures of health and claim they are "rearing to go." The Supply Train was the last to leave France and they claim the transport couldn't go any too fast for them for they had enough for this time.

They received the biggest surprise of their life as they neared the port when a boat came out to meet them and a gentleman with a megaphone who was on the boat announced the different representatives from cities of Wisconsin who were present to welcome them and among the first called out was Mayor O'Neil of Chippewa Falls. The fellows were overwhelmed with joy and a general cheering lasted until they landed and he gave them the first warning that

the people of Chippewa Falls were anxiously waiting to greet them. As they got off the transport Mayor O'Neil gave them each the glad hand and on behalf of the city of Chippewa Falls welcomed them back to God's Country once more. Right away it reminded them of home for Mr. O'Neil presented them each with a five spot and as one fellow said, "I certainly know I'm home now as this is just like getting money from home." They left there for Camp Grant where they were "canned" and received the red chevron which they have been eagerly awaiting.

TUSCANIA GROUP PLANS REUNION

**Local Members of Survivors
of Torpedoed Ship to At-
tend Meeting.**

Several hundred members of the National Tuscania Survivors' Association are expected to attend the group's annual reunion in Minneapolis, Minn., Saturday night and Sunday, according to S. F. Staples, Wausau, association president, including a number from Chippewa Falls.

There are ten members of the association living in Chippewa Falls including H. A. Doerge, P. J. Pangborn, Hans Christianson, Edward Paul, George Borgenheimer, Edward Bushland, Mike Cosgrove, Louis Hartman, Oscar Bjork and William Gereau.

On February 5, 1918, the Tuscania with more than 2,000 American soldiers aboard, was torpedoed and sunk off the coast of Ireland with a loss of more than 200 lives.

After the war, the survivors organized the association and have met annually since. The association has a membership of more than 900, including many Wisconsin men.

Among the units aboard were the 107th military police, drawn from the Fourth and Sixth Wisconsin infantry, the 107th supply train, drawn from the Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Wisconsin infantry, and several other companies of the 32nd division.

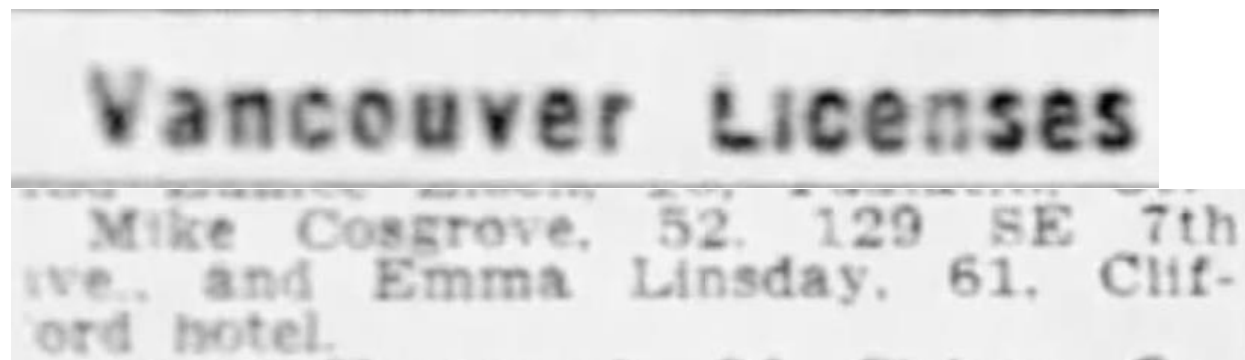

LINEMAN KILLED BY CURRENT OF HIGH VOLTAGE

Fletcher Smeathers Touches
Uninsulated Wire With
Finger Tip, Making Con-
nection In Tree.

Fletcher Smeathers, 43 years old, 530 Crittenden street, a lineman for Municipal electric plant, was electrocuted in a tree at Fifth and Monarch avenue, at 3:30 o'clock Sunday afternoon when he came into contact with a live wire, which sent 2,200 volts through his body, causing instant death.

Smeathers, with a crew of men from the Municipal light plant, in charge of Andy Smith, was working on an emergency job making a connection at that point for the Nolan Construction company, for lighting a new sewer shaft. He had ascended the tree and had measured an arm used for holding up the wires, when the middle finger on his left hand is believed to have come into contact with the tip end of the high voltage wire.

Slumped Over In Tree

The ground crew saw Smeathers as he slumped over in the tree where he hung until a rope was secured and his body lowered to the ground. An effort was made to restore life by the use of a pulmotor.

An examination of the body showed that he came into contact with the wire only on his finger tip. The current passed through his body and came out on the side of his legs to which he had his cleats for climbing poles attached.

Experienced Electrician

Mr. Smeathers was born at Maceo, December 3, 1888. He served twenty-six months in the United States army during the World war, twelve months being overseas. He was connected seven years with the light plant at St. Louis and one year with the Detroit-Edison at Detroit. He had been with the Owensboro light plant since the first of the year.

Besides his widow, Mrs. Helen Allen Smeathers, he is survived by his mother, Mrs. C. J. Smeathers, of the city, one sister, Miss Georgia Smeathers and one brother, Drury Smeathers, also a niece Mrs. Urey Jones and a nephew, Howard Clark.

Funeral services will be held at 3 o'clock this afternoon when the residence, 530 Crittenden street, with the Rev. A. P. Lyon pastor of Settle Memorial church in charge. Interment will be at Elmwood. The active pallbearers will be A. L. Bishop, Mark Morris, Clark Coombs, Andy Smith, Walter Pate and Wilbur Pate. Honorary—Logan Meredith, Henry Cline, R. E. Miller, James C. Ellis, J. B. Burton and J. D. Russell.

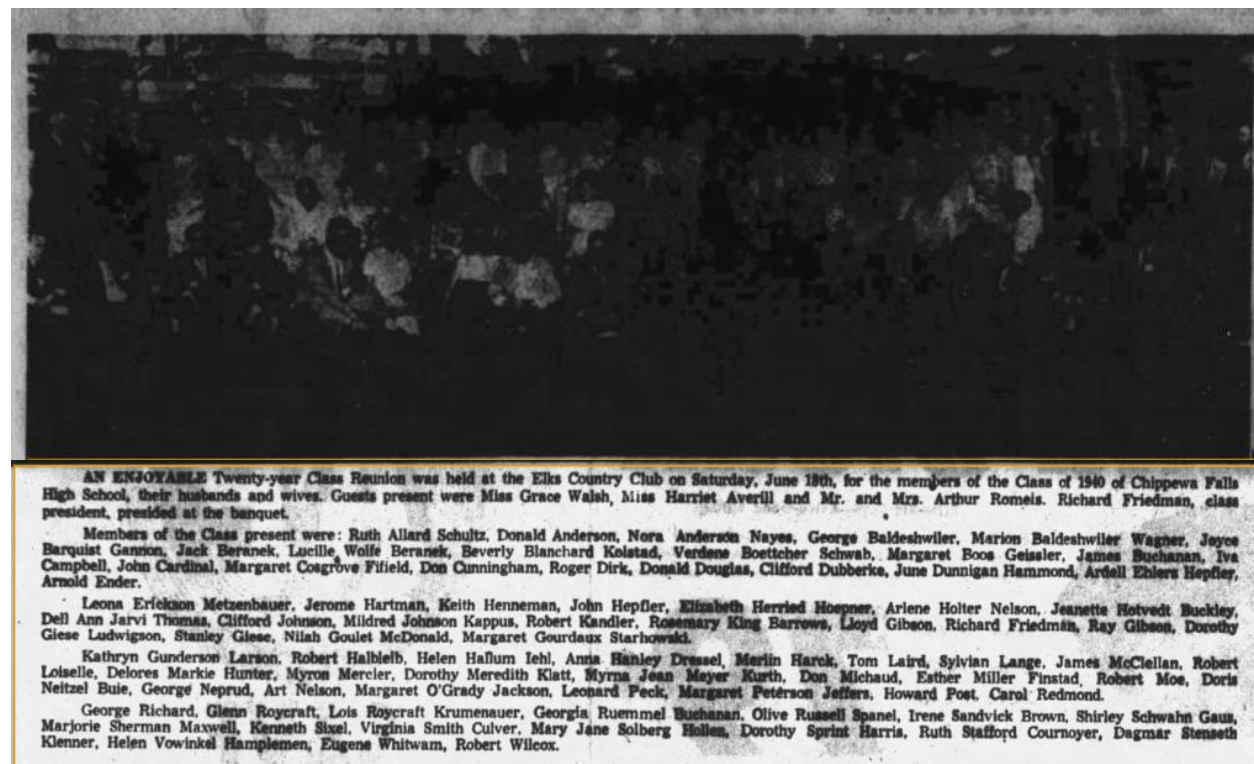

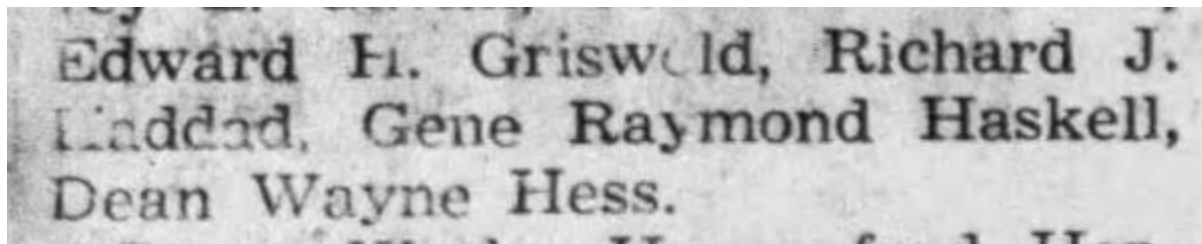

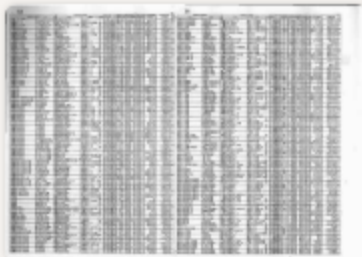

City Man Meets Death Xmas Eve

Fatally Injured In
Collision With Car

Peter Cosgrove, 63, 421 Poplar street, was fatally injured Christmas Eve at 6 o'clock in a collision with an automobile driven by Mrs. Robert Rose, 1136 Warren street, at the intersection of East Grand avenue and Culver street. He was reported dead upon arrival at St. Joseph's hospital.

Peter J. Cosgrove was born August 30, 1891, in Chippewa Falls, the son of Bernard and Elen Cosgrove, and was a life-long resident of the city.

For the past 12 years he had been employed by the Chippewa

Falls Woolen Mills. He was a veteran of World War One, having served in the 30th Machinegun Battalion.
