A. & M. will send the ten men, whose expenses will be paid by the Corn Show authorities, and in addition will send five men on their own expenses.

Since examinations were concluded week before last the A. & M. speed boys have been working diligently in preparation for the meet at Dallas next week, and they are prepared to make some good records at the Dallas speed show. Assistant Coaches Clutter of Ames (Iowa) fame, and Talmot, a weight man from Oklahoma A. & M., have been working diligently with Captain Joe Turner and his squad of thirty men, and hope to pick a team that will place A. & M. on the map this year in the track world.

Among some of the cadets who are showing up good are Captain Turner, who covers the quarter mile in good time; H. H. Rothe of Hondo looks good in pole vaulting; J. S. Cover of San Antonio is showing good in the 100-yard and 220-yard dashes; Peabody, formerly a track star at Fort Worth High School, is looking good in the 220-yard and the quarter mile; and in the shot put and in throwing the discus, Nick Braumiller of Texarkana promises to make some good records.

All in all, it will be a classy team that will represent A. & M. at Dallas in spite of the fact that their training season was cut short by term examinations.

The Historic Texas Cemetery marker of the Texas Historical Commission reads: John B. Cover (1857-1914) and his wife, Virginia Steele Cover (180-1925), donated land in the late 1900s that became the Cover Cemetery. The oldest marked grave is dated Nov. 1896. Many Cover family members, close friends and veterans are buried in the cemetery, including Tommy Ferrel, who lived to be 107 years old. In 1994, a second tract was added to the cemetery through the estate of Dr. Ellen C. Cover (1886-1965). Dr. Ellen Cover, a physician and surgeon, also donated land for the Cover Youth Center and established a

scholarship program for Cover family members. Cover family descendants maintain this historic cemetery and its records.
