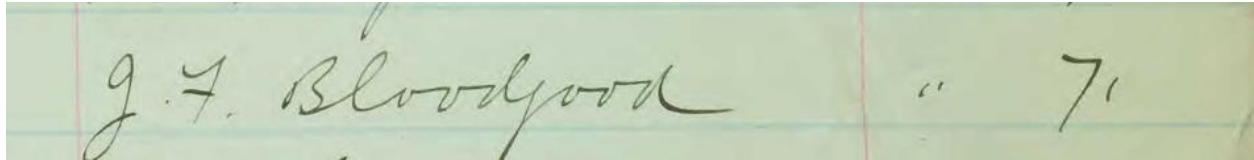

Two Flushing Youths Tell of Their Escape

Flushing, March 2.—Letters were received here yesterday from William Clabby, of Hicks place, and Joseph Crawford, of Osgood place, two more Flushing boys, who were on the torpedoed troopship *Tuscania*. In his letter to his parents Clabby said:

"I left New York from Hoboken on the *Tuscania*, January 22, and arrived at Halifax on the twenty-fifth. Saw the ruins of explosion. Left there that night for Liverpool. I was not seasick, and everything went well until 6:20 last night. All of a sudden there was a crash and the lights went out.

"We had had boat drill every day, with life preservers, each man being assigned to a boat or raft in case of an accident. I was assigned to a boat on Deck B. As the stairway was broken I slid down a lifeline to a raft and kept warm by rowing until picked up by a trawler, which landed me in Larne. I was cared for by a good Samaritan, a fine old Irish woman named Mrs. O'Neill. In fact, all of the natives treated us fine, giving up dry clothing and doing everything for our comfort. While this is all I can say at present, I will write again in a little while, with love to all."

"After a great and awful experi-

ence I am here and safe," writes Crawford to his mother. "I have been all over this place, and it sure is a beautiful place. I have tried to get a chance to write before, and I hope you received a previous letter. I am a whole lot wiser and have seen things, and know what it is to be at death's door. The people here have treated us royally since we arrived, and I am thankful to the English and Irish for food and clothing.

"We were torpedoed at 6 o'clock and didn't leave the ship until 8:30. We had an awful time, but were saved by a couple of destroyers, and we sure were thankful to see them pull alongside. We slid down the ropes, and it was a great sensation to get our feet on the destroyer. Well, mother, if you get this let Mary know and I will write her today. Good-by, mother, and God bless you. Your son."

Both young men are members of the 213th Aero Squadron, and are now somewhere in Ireland.

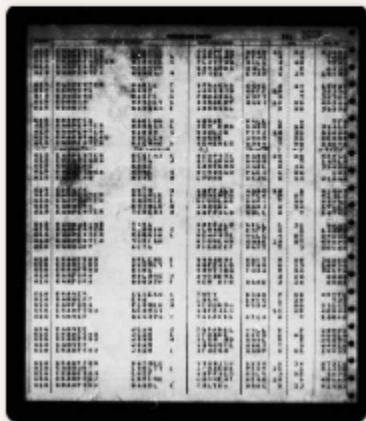

Judge delays decision on releasing sex offender

William E. Vars, 61 and in ill health, is serving a 15-year sentence

VERO BEACH — A judge said he will rule later whether to allow a 61-year-old convicted sex offender to go free because of health reasons, even though he described the man's crime as "disgusting."

Circuit Judge Dan L. Vaughn, who sentenced William E. Vars to 15 years in prison on Feb. 9, heard pleas for mercy Friday from five women, including Vars' companion, who said he won't survive in prison because of diabetes, hypertension and probable kidney failure.

Vars went to prison after pleading guilty to committing a lewd act while naked near his backyard in view of a mother, her two children and a family friend who were sunbathing by their pool.

In a motion to mitigate Vars' sentence, Assistant Public Defender Jennifer Hixson asked that Vars be allowed to return to his Vero Beach home

in the 1200 block of 44th Avenue and undergo sex-offender counseling.

"His 15-year sentence is tantamount to a life sentence," Hixson told the court. "He has diabetes, his kidneys are nearing dialysis and he has pain in his legs from shrapnel in Vietnam. The reason he pleaded guilty on Feb. 9 was because he didn't want the state to have to pay for a trial."

Vaughn said he will consider Hixson's motion and the testimony of his friends, but told Vars: "No matter how you try to slice it, the offense you committed was a disgusting, criminal thing to do. You can't rationalize it, you can't justify it."

Vars' companion, Joan Synek, said that last June 14, Vars committed the lewd act "after mixing his medications with disastrous results."

"Nothing will be gained by putting him away for the rest of his life," Synek said. "Please let him come home with restitution. Please temper justice with mercy."

The Rev. Robin Reiter of Unity Center of Vero Beach said Vars baked cakes for the church and volunteered for other church-oriented activities.

"I've never experienced him as a dangerous man," Reiter said.

But Assistant State Attorney Adam Chrzan said Vars does not deserve freedom because he previously served 3 ½ years in prison for the 1991 sexual assault of a mentally deficient woman, whom he assaulted behind a restaurant garbage bin.

Chrzan said last June, a sheriff's deputy observed Vars standing naked even while members of the nearby family were waving a cell phone, threatening to call police.

"We've heard testimony about his illness, but that didn't stop him from committing his act that day, and it won't stop him from doing it again," Chrzan said. "We hear that he bakes cakes and volunteers at church, but his act wasn't committed in front of fellow volunteers, it was committed in front of children."

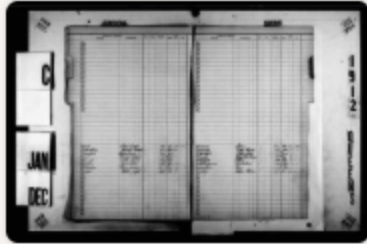

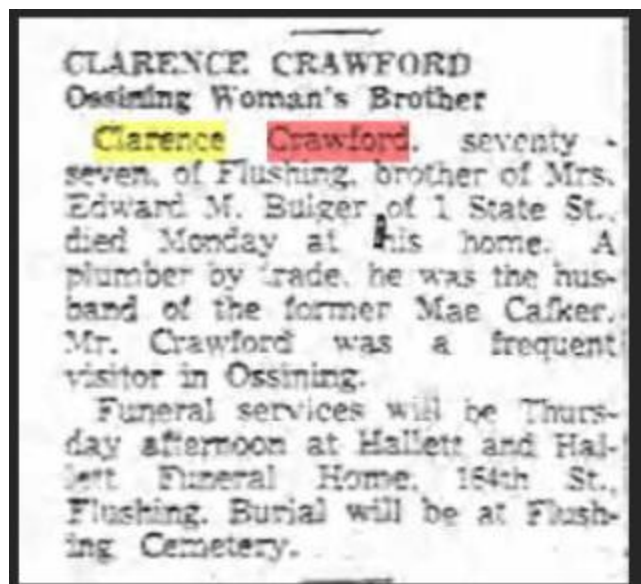

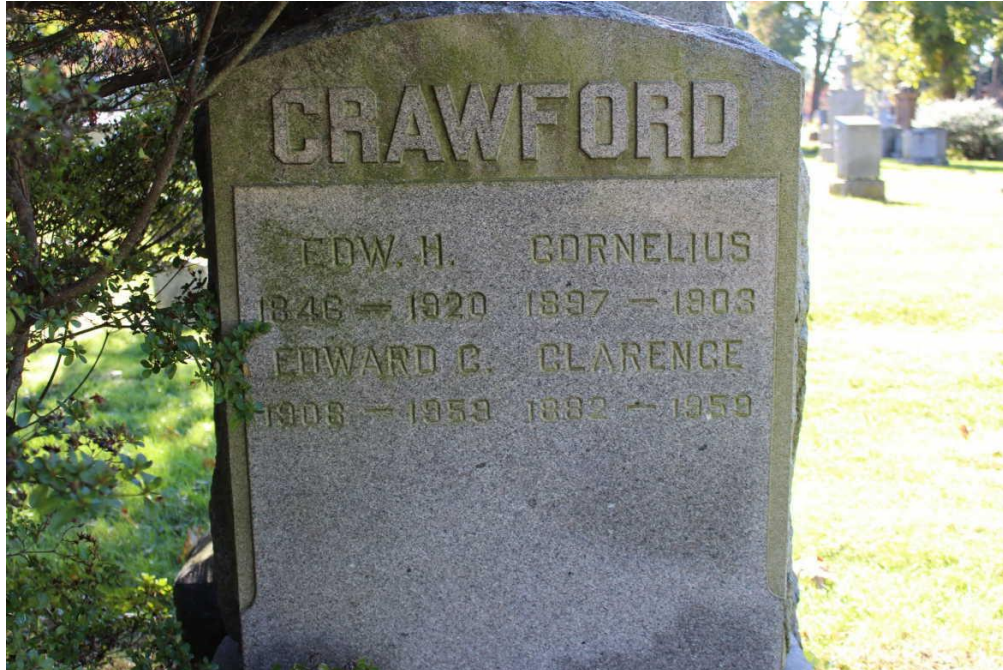

“Brooklyn Standard Union” 23 Sep 1920 p 18 – Ira L. Terry sold these properties for the estate of Edward H. Crawford: 19 Covert Place, 20 Covert Place, 84 Congress Avenue, 120 Congress Avenue & 121 Linder Avenue.

“Brooklyn Daily Eagle” 5 Nov 1935 p 6 – The Glen Cove post of the American Legion installed Harry Aronsberg as its new president on 4 Nov 1935. Joseph Crawford was named to the executive board.

“New York Daily News” 17 Nov 1935 p 13 – “Aiding Idle Vets” - The Glen Cove post of the American Legion has set up an employment bureau for veterans. Joseph Crawford, secretary of the committee, is enrolling veterans, and contacting firms & homeowners for full- and part-time jobs.
