Leland W. Crump

Leland W. Crump, 99, of Boise, died Tuesday, Nov. 27, 1990, in a local nursing home.

Funeral services will be at 11 a.m. Friday, Nov. 30, at the Alden-Waggoner Chapel. Chaplain Bill Williams of the Idaho State Veterans Home will officiate. Private burial will follow at Meridian Cemetery.

Mr. Crump was born Sept. 4, 1891, at Ft. Bidwell, Calif., a son of Thomas and Johanna Crump. He married Mary Jessie Daniels at Vancouver, Wash., on June 24, 1923. For most of his life he had operated ranches in southeastern Ore., in the Steens Mountain country near Andrews, and also at Adell. He moved to Boise in 1973.

He was a member of the Veterans of World War I, had served in France, and had been shipwrecked off the coast of Ireland.

Mr. Crump was an avid gardener and continued his love of gardening after moving to the Idaho Veterans Home in recent years. He had won several awards for prize winning flowers at the Idaho State Fair.

Survivors include a daughter, Linda (Mrs. Howard) Freeman of Ft. Worth, Tex.; two sons, John W. Crump of Lakeview, Ore., and Leland Daniel Crump of Winthrop, Wash.; a sister, Viola Smith of Mill City, Ore.; eight grandchildren; four great-grandchildren; and several nieces and nephews. He was preceded in death by his wife in 1984, and a daughter, Virginia Nelson in 1976.

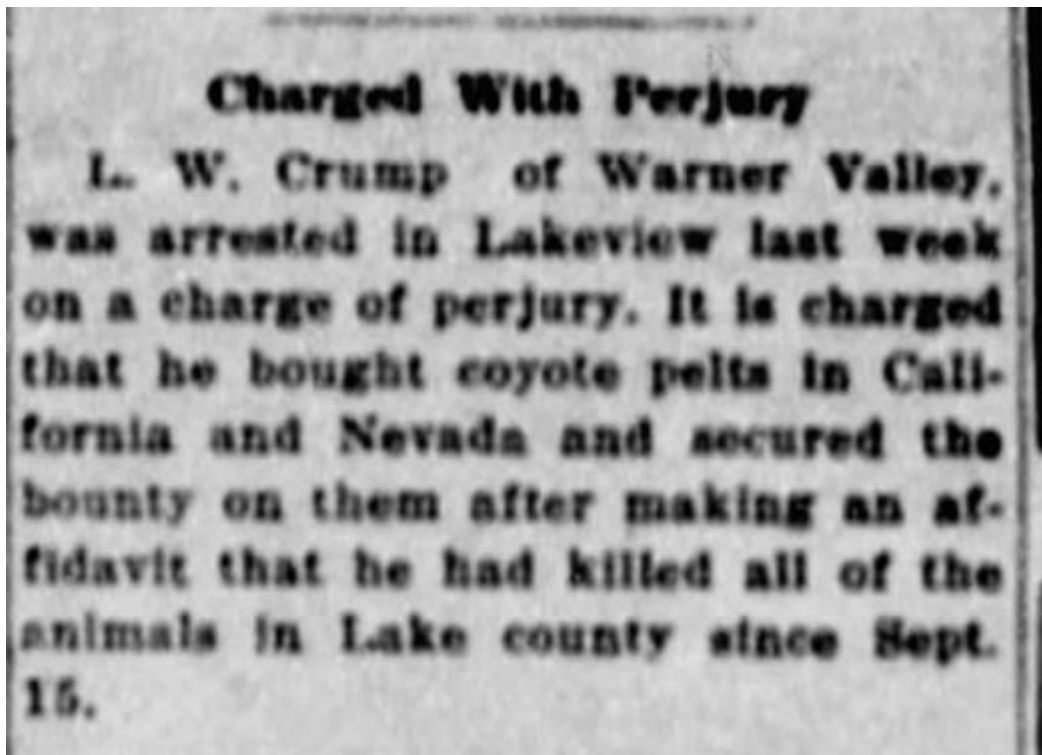

F. M. SCHADLER ESTATE SETTLED

An order discharging Mrs. Anna H. Wardin as administratrix of the estate of Frederick Max Schadler was issued by Judge B. F. Curler this week, closing a matter which has been before the probate court for the last five years. Judge Curler held that the terms of a decree of final distribution entered May 27 had been fully executed.

The decree awarded the following amounts: To Charles A. Crump \$280; to the administrator as guardian of the estate of Ray-istrix for expenses in closing the estate, \$7.50; to Price and Merrill, attorney fees of \$3500 of which \$1000 had previously been paid; to Johanna C. Crump, \$6543.55 and personal property; to August H. Schadler, Wilhelmina Schadler and Mrs. Wardin each \$6626.05; to Frederick F. Crump \$612.60 and carpenter tools; to Leland W. Mrs. Wardin's Estate \$75,000

Mrs. Anna H. Wardin, University of Nevada regent who died here on May 27, left an estate in Reno valued at about \$75,000, it was stated in a petition filed in the district court Monday by Frederick Herz of Reno and Charles A. Crump of Adel, Ore.

Mrs. Wardin's property included houses and two lots on West Liberty street between Granite and Hill streets, cash, securities, a promissory note and household furniture, all worth approximately \$60,000, and total value does not exceed \$75,000, according to the petitioners.

A will made by Mrs. Wardin last May 3 names a number of surviving relatives and four organizations as beneficiaries. Sharing the estate with a number of nieces and nephews will be Adah chapter No. 4, order of Eastern Star of Reno; Young Women's Christian association of Reno; welfare fund of Ammon-Ra temple, No. 56, Daughters of the Nile of Reno, and Father E. J. Flanagan, for his work at Boys' Town, Neb.

Nieces and nephews named as heirs are Ethel Crump Corbett, Fullerton, Calif.; Esther Crump Johnson, Long Beach, Calif.; Viola Crump Satterlee, Boulder City; Fred F. Crump, Chico, Calif.; Leland W. Germany, single, was a lodger with Samuel C. & Blanche M. Dickey in San Francisco, San Francisco CO. The census, undated as to its enumeration date, listed Raymond as a factory worker for automobiles (line 88). - In 1940, Raymond Crump (36 OR, single), #2428, was a patient in the Eastern Oregon State Hospital (Mental Hospital) as of 5 Apr 1940. He is listed on line 23; the hospital was located in Pendleton, Umatilla OR. – In 1950 Raymond (44 OR, never married) is listed on line 24 for the Inmates of the Eastern Oregon State Hospital (State Mental Hospital ~~Insane~~) in Pendleton, Umatilla OR. - Buried in IOOF Cemetery, Lakeview, Lake OR. F: 60708654
- **Thomas Alexander Crump, Jr.**, 7 Jun 1906 Lakeview, Lake OR – 16 Jul 1988 Laguna Hills, Orange CA. - Husband of Dorothy Helen Steimle (1907-1963, F: 81841923) whom he married 28 Aug 1937 in Multnomah Co. OR. Buried in Oak Hill Memorial Park, Portland, Multnomah OR. F: 81842052
- **Elmer Wardin Crump**, 28 Apr 1908 Adel, Lake OR – 25 Oct 1993 Medford, Jackson OR. - Husband of Alice Abelset (1909-1983, F: 77201667). Referred to in newspaper articles as “E. Ward Crump.” The married surname of his mother Johanna’s sister

Anna, from whom he inherits money in 1944, is Wardin. - Buried in San Jose CA. F: 77201383

- **Viola Ruth Crump Satterlee Smith**, 13 Nov 1912 Adel, Lake OR – 16 Dec 2000 Salem, Marion OR. - Married to Jesse Thomas Satterlee (1908-1957, F: 81981503) on 2 Jul 1934 in Alturas, Modoc CA. - Married to Edwin Phillip Smith (1915-1994, F: 80546425) as Viola Satterlee on 4 Jun 1960 in Santa Clara Co. CA. - Buried in Fairview Cemetery, Linn Co. OR. F: 77633884

Pre-war:

“Eugene (OR) Morning Register” Wed., 8 Jan 1913 p 4 – L.W. Crump, son of T.A. Crump of Warner Valley brought in last Friday over 86 coyote & bobcat hides & scalps to get their bounties from the county. He swore an affidavit that all had been killed in Lake County since 17 Sep 1912. He was paid \$135. On 3 Nov 1912 he also got a bounty on 33 coyotes.

“Oregon Sunday Journal” (Portland OR) 21 Oct 1917 p 11 – Donating \$100 to the Liberty Loan was L.W. Crump.

Wartime:

“Oregon Daily Journal” 10 Feb 1918 p 12 – on the partial list of survivors released 9 Feb 1918 is Leland W. Crump of Adel OR.

“Oregon Daily Journal” (Portland OR) 3 Jul 1919 p 9 – Troops from OR landed Wednesday, 3 Jul 1919, including Leland W. Crump of Adel OR.

Post-war:

“Bend (OR) Bulletin” 8 May 1934 p 5 – L.W. Crump, stockman of Andrews, was in Bend yesterday to meet his family who were returning from a visit in western OR.

“Nevada State Journal” (Reno NV) 6 Jun 1944 p 12 – An estate of over \$60,000 was left by the deceased Mrs. Anna H. Wardin, University of NV regent, who died in Reno NV on 27 May 1944. [This is Johanna Crump’s sister]. Her heirs include [Johanna’s children]: her niece Ethel Crump Corbett (Fullerton CA), niece Esther Crump Johnson (Long Beach CA), niece Viola Crump Satterlee (Boulder City) – nephew Fred E. Crump (Chico CA) – nephew Charles A. Crump of Adel OR – nephew Thomas A. Crump Jr. (Jackson Heights NY) – nephew E. Ward Crump (San Mateo CA) – Raymond J. Crump (Pendleton OR) – nephew Ralph J. Crump (Salem OR). Then listed among “other named in the will” but not named as a nephew is Leland W. Crump (Andrews OR). Each of Johanna’s children got \$662.50 except for Fred E. Crump who got \$612.60 & carpenter tools, and Leland W. Crump who got \$637.60 & 2 watches.
