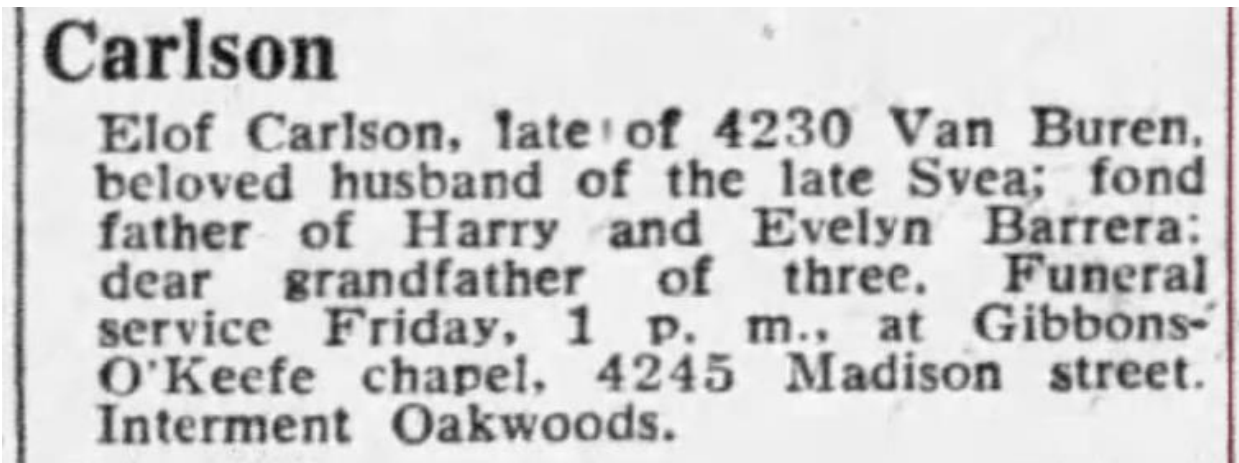

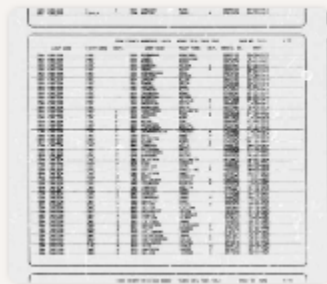

In 1917 Carl was a janitor, living at 4926 Kimbarks Ave., Chicago, a declarant.- In 1940, living at 1940 E. 54th St., Chicago IL – Carl (47 Sweden, janitor in an apartment building), Agnes (45 Sweden), Kenneth (19 IL) & Richard (14 IL). – On his TX death certificate, he is listed as a retired janitor, maintenance, son of Per Carlson, SSN 349-09-1378. - Buried in Sparkman Hillcrest Memorial Park, Dallas, Dallas TX. F: 144927038

- Amanda Nilsson/Carlson Hawkinson, 21 Mar 1894 Svensköp, Malmöhus, Skåne, Sweden – 4 Jul 1984 Redmond, King WA. In 1910, Amanda Carlson, 16 Sweden, parents b. IL Federal Naturalization Records, District Court for the Northern District of IL – application 29 Apr 1920. his naturalization says Aug 1913] – and it is likely the “Mauretania” sailed back from NY to take another group of passenger on 8 Aug 1913 as August indicated.
