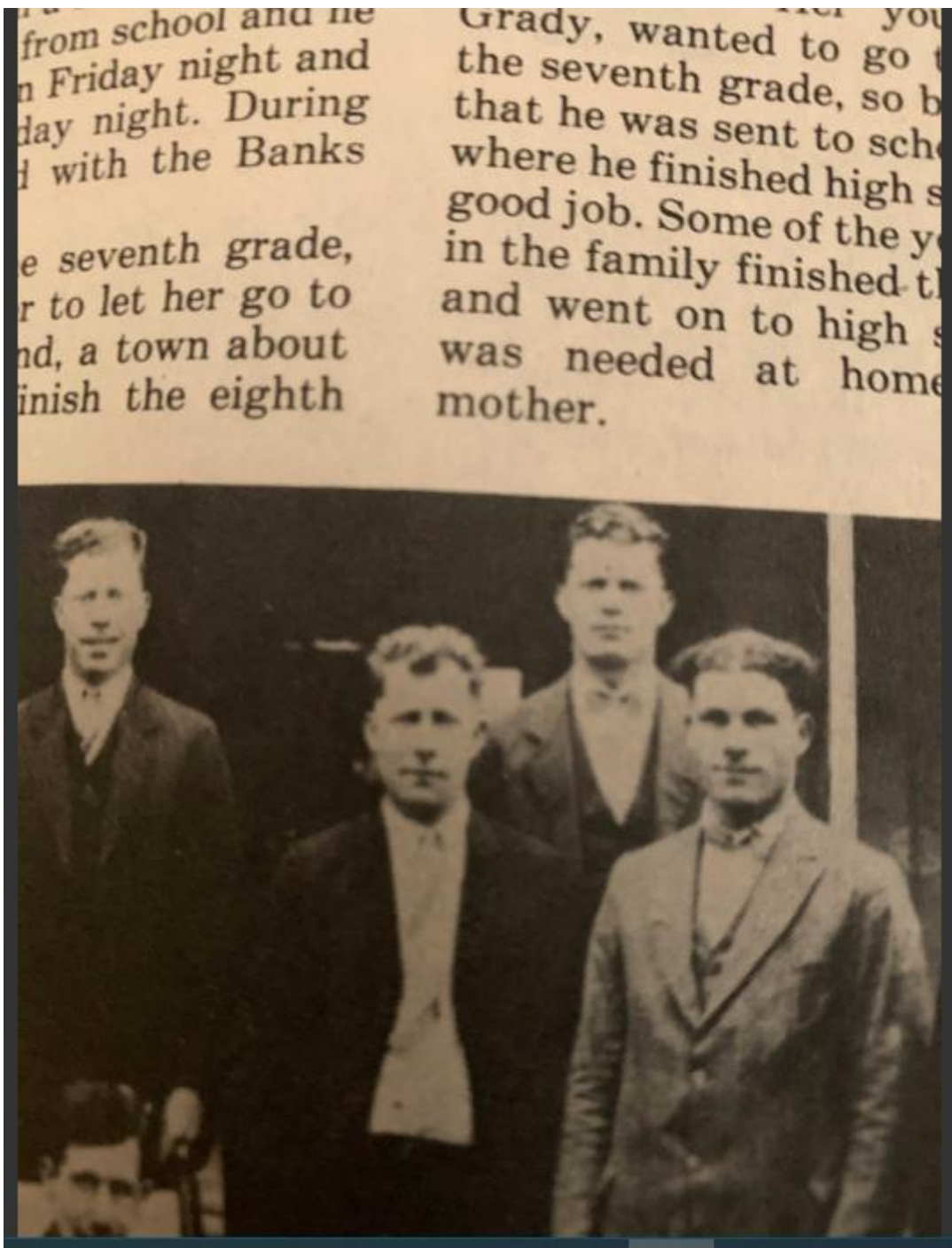

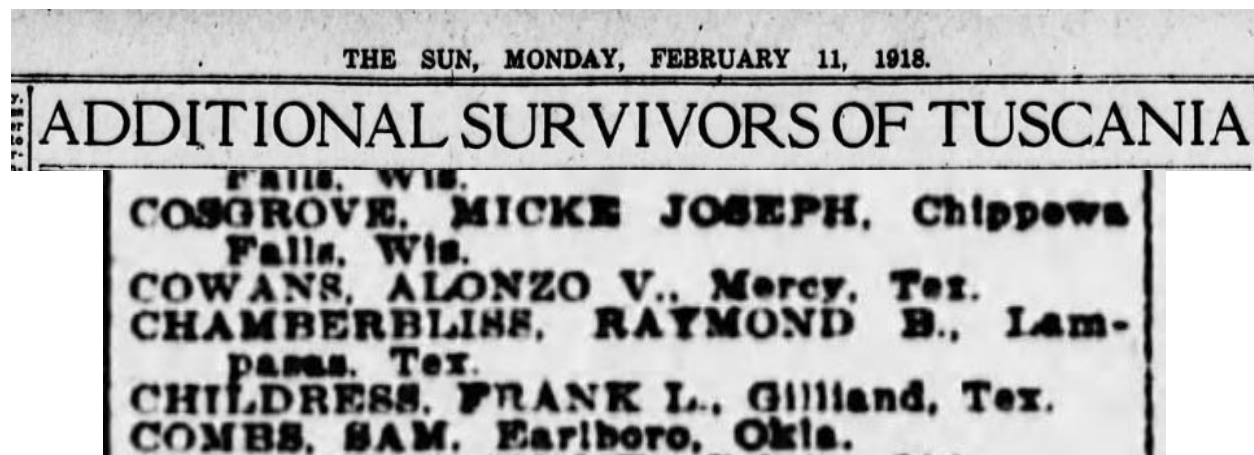

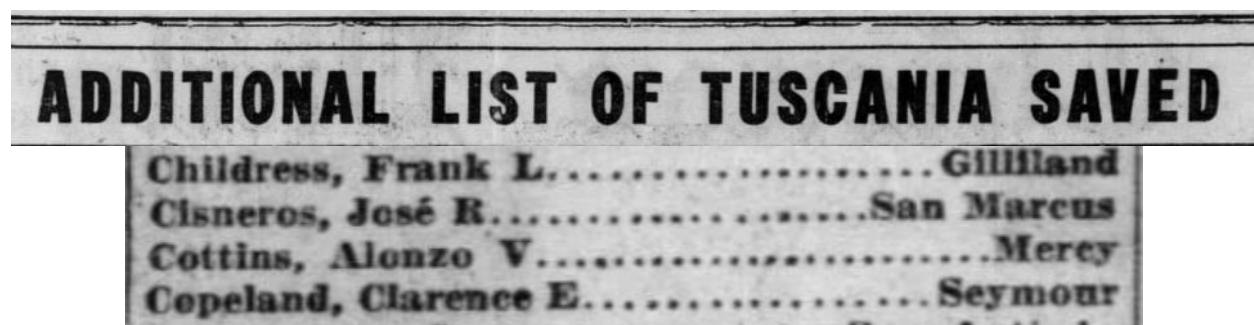

Plans Discussed Monday Night; Committees Named

Plans for the Dairy Day program to be held in Cleveland on May 15 were discussed Monday night at a meeting of the general committee, according to county agent G. L. Hart. The following business men and dairymen are members of the general committee: Billy Kirkham, chairman; Jerry Daniel, Theo Scott, J. E. Wigley, L. O. Ward, W. S. Burchfield, and M. Jackson.

Various committees were appointed at the Monday night meeting. Leon Love, manager of the Phoenix Dairy in Cleveland was appointed chairman of the cattle committee. Members to assist Mr. Love on this important committee are H. E. Kirk, Lonnie Carnes, H. C. Rabe, George Owens, Dan Burch, James Puckett, and A. Hohn. Other members will be added later.

Pete Pressley and Jennings Bryan were appointed on the grounds committee. The judging contest committee members appointed are Garth Christopher and J. E. Seamon. Publicity committee, L. R. Ables and Margaret Ramage. The finance committee was discussed and Chairman Kirkham plans to appoint members to this committee within the next day or two.

The Dairy Day program is spon-

sored by the Texas A. & M. College, Extension Service, in co-operation with dairymen and business men in Liberty and surrounding counties. It offers an opportunity for all interested parties, producers, business men and educational workers to join in a program for better dairying. De-

tailed plans of the program will be announced later.

Arrangements have been made for members of the various committees to meet at Kirkham Brothers' Feed Store in Cleveland, Monday night, April 15 to further develop plans for the Dairy Day program.

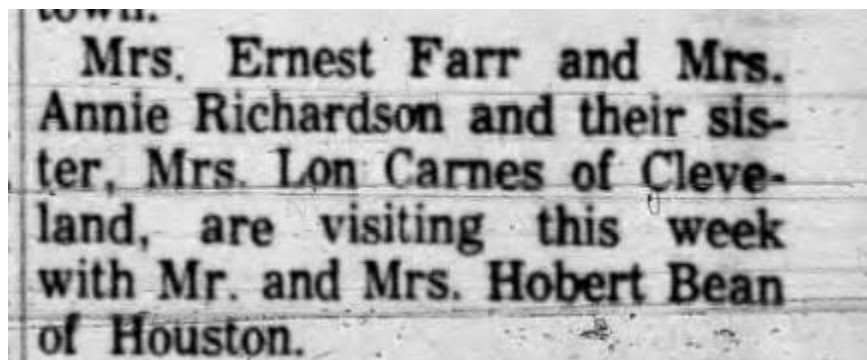

He belongs to the Church of Christ.

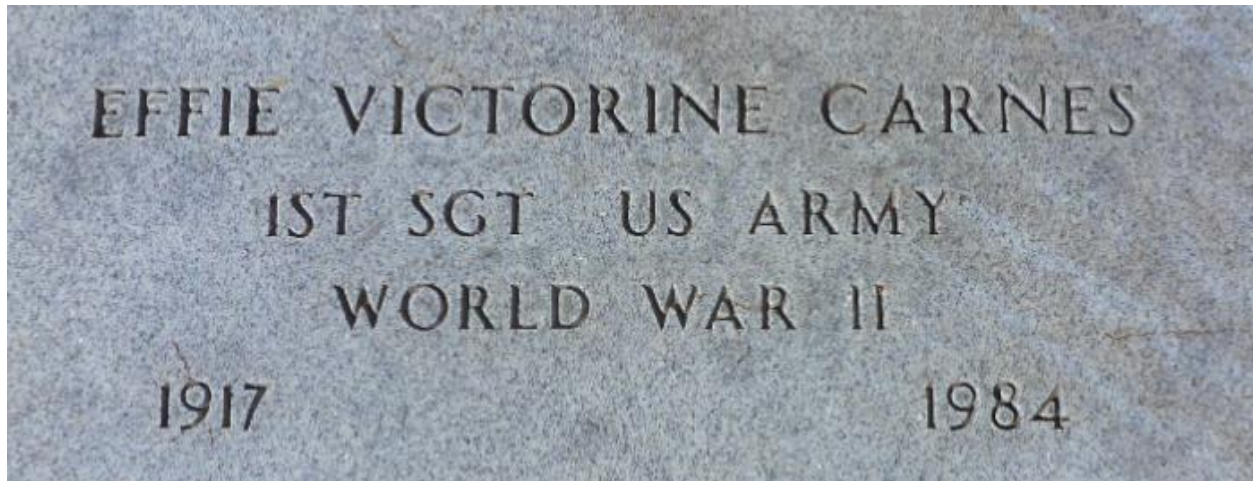
