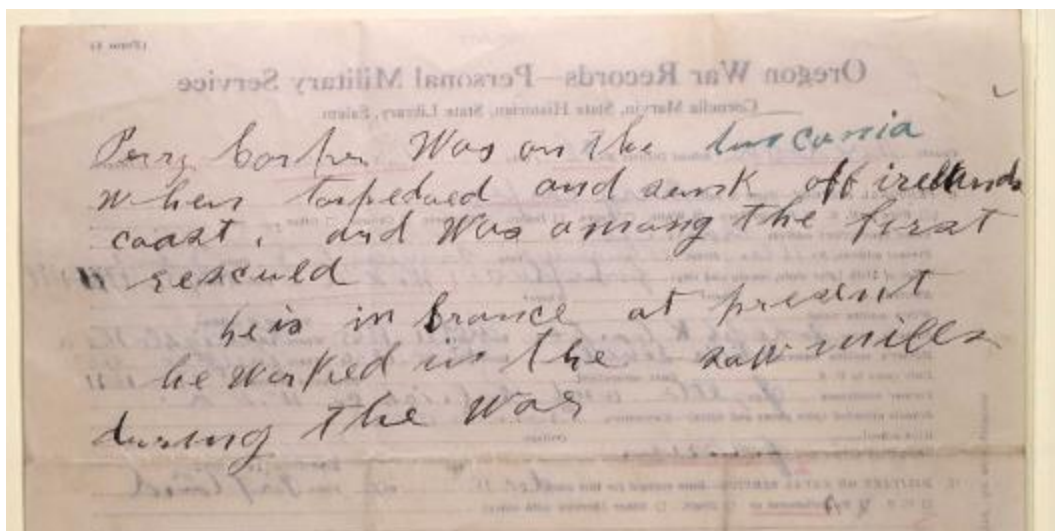

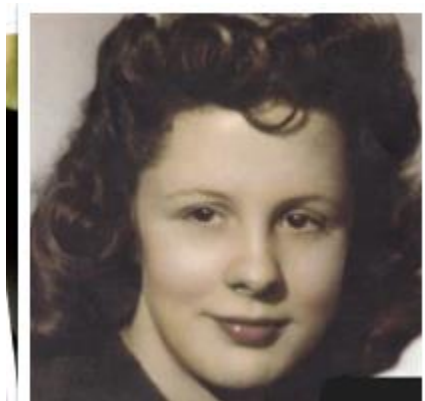

The sympathy of many friends go out to Mrs. Peterson who, in the last 10 months has lost her father, a brother, one son and now her husband.

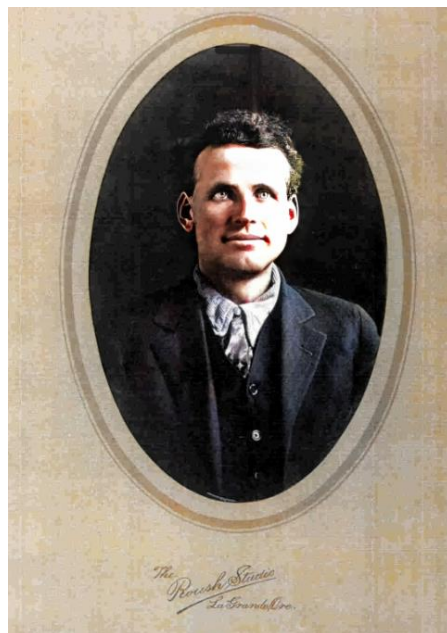
