3 SOLDIERS HELD AFTER ADMITTING TAKING CAR

GREENVILLE, Ky., Dec. 6—
Three Ft. Campbell soldiers are being held in the Muhlenberg County jail in Greenville pending notification of authorities at Ft. Campbell that they have been incarcerated on a charge of taking a car without the owners consent, according to County Judge Cyril Shadowen.

State Trooper Phillip Stone states he received a call at 8:30 a. m. today that three men had run off the road into a swamp near Drakesboro and had taken duffle bags and abandoned the car where it was hung up. Investigation revealed that three men had started hitchhiking from Drakesboro and had caught a ride in a pickup truck.

Stone stated that he anticipated something was not in order and apprehended the men and brought them to Greenville where they admitted that they had taken the car in Nicholasville, Ky.

Investigation revealed the car was the property of Johnny L. Stinnett. Further investigation and examination revealed that the men were soldiers from Ft. Campbell.

The men being held, according to county Jailer Otis Mercer, identified themselves as: Staff Sgt. Ponciano Carreles, 18, 11th Replacement Co.; Pfc Irvin R. Bennett, 23, 11th Medical Bn., Ambulance Co.; and Pfc. David W. Baker, 18, 11th Medical Bn., Ambulance Co.

All men were wearing civilian clothes when apprehended according to Trooper Stone.

Burglar's error

SAN JOSE — Ponciano Carreles chose the wrong house to burglarize early Sunday morning, police said today.

The house he chose happened to be behind a home being staked out by two San Jose plainclothes policemen investigating another case.

When Carreles, 36, parked a car in the driveway of the stake-out home, according to the two officers, Loyis Hernandez and Edward Caragher, they sat in their car and watched Carreles burglarize the other house.

They said they arrested Carreles with \$150 cash, a movie camera and projector, a typewriter, a hair dryer, two women's purses and a dresser drawer full of jewelry and other items.

Carreles, of 365 N. 16th St., San Jose, was booked into the county jail on charges of burglary and possession of stolen property.
