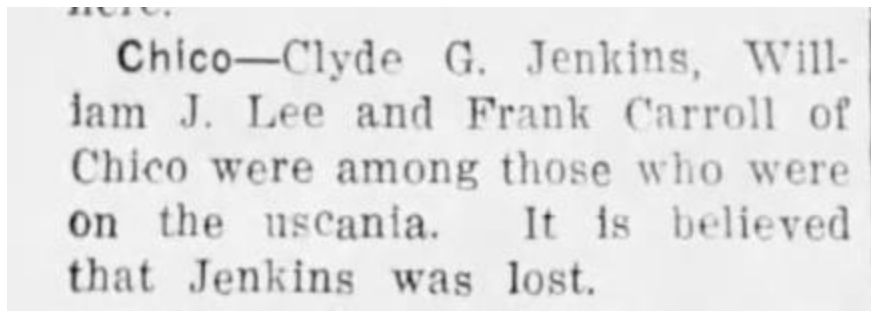

F, 4th Battalion, 20th Engineers ---; 18th Co., 20th Engineers to desertion. Private. Overseas 24 Jan 1918 to 14 Feb 1917. Deserted 12 Mar 1919.
