GABRIEL CHARTRAND [CHALTRAW] FAMILY

Gabriel and Rose (Garrent) Chartrand came in 1871 from Montreal, Canada, and were French Catholics. They had five children: Treffley, in Canada, Joseph married Elizabeth Biskner, daughter of Louis and Fannie (Breauseau) Biskner, in 1882. Their children were William, Anna, John, Charles, Louis, Joseph and Nellie. Father Joseph born in 1863, died in 1914. Mother born in 1858, died 1929. Francis, unmarried, in Sagaming. Odeal in Chicago, Nellie in Canada.

Charles Chaltraw married Hazel Armstrong, daughter of George and Mary Armstrong, in 1917. They had one son, Wendell, killed in World War II, in France on June 27, 1944 at the age of 24. Wendell was the first boy killed from Standish Township. Charles died in 1975. He had farmed on Worth Road.

Louis Chaltraw married Mae Gauthier, daughter of Richard and Kate Gauthier, who lived on Deep River Road near Worth. They had five children: Leonard, who lives in Standish and has seven children; Audrey (Mrs. Joseph LeVert), three children; Richard, killed in World War II; Katherine (Mrs. Tom Mahoney), Farmington, four children; Alice (Mrs. Tony Zuchnik), Pinconning, one son. Louis Chaltraw served in WWI with the 128th Ambulance Co., out of Bay City in the 32nd Division of the Army. On February 2, 1918 his ship was torpedoed off

the coast of Ireland with many casualties. The Division was made up of all Michigan and Wisconsin men. Louis took over the Chaltraw barber shop in Standish in 1924, and Leonard is operating it now.

All the children of Joseph Chaltraw Sr. are now deceased.

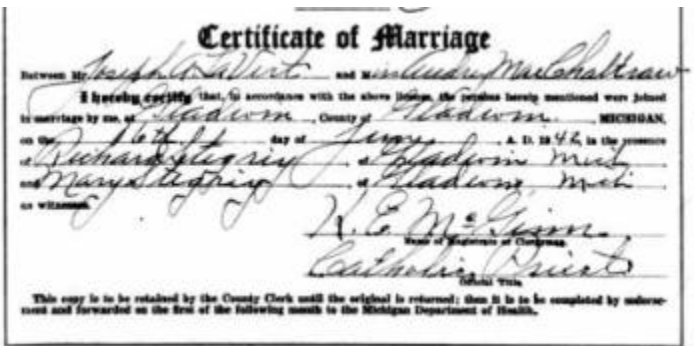

EXPECT BOOZE CASE TO BE BECIEDED TODAY

The case against John Chaltraw, charged with illegal possession of liquor, as a result of a raid by police officers on the combination barber shop and restaurant at 525 Lapeer avenue, said to be owned by his brother, William Chaltraw, and himself, was expected to go to the jury in circuit court Tuesday afternoon.

The state completed its testimony early Tuesday and the defense introduced William Chaltraw, the brother, to build up the claim of the defendant that he had gone into the place jut before the raid to make himself a sandwich. VETERAN'S PROTEST

Editor The News—What I would like to know is what is an emergency?

My father, Joseph Edward Chattraw, passed away Saturday, March 23, at 6:30 o'clock. Not more than 15 minutes later, I asked that my brother, Dale, who is stationed in Germany be brought home for his father's funeral. Is that so hard to do for a boy that has served three different times in Uncle Sam's Army? Some of that time was spent in the Korean so-called police action, in which I myself spent nine months with him over there.

Didn't I call the Red Cross fast enough? It seems to me they could have flown him home in time to see his father before he was laid to rest.

Money — I thought millions of people gave every year for just such emergencies as I am writing about now. What I would like to know is how come some servicemen come home from overseas in an emergency such as this and some don't?

Editor's note: Mr. Chaltraw's protest has been relayed by The Saginaw News to the Saginaw County Chapter, American Red Cross, and the following statement has been received from the chapter:

Leaves are controlled by the military authorities. The job of the Red Cross is to provide verified information about home conditions that might require the presence of the serviceman in question. The information is obtained at the request of military authorities or the serviceman or his family. The Red Cross submits a report without any recommendation of its own. The report may, however, include the recommendations of doctors, lawyers or others. The decision is always made by the military authorities. Red Cross has no authority to grant or deny a leave.

In the case of Dale Chaltraw, the Saginaw County Chapter, American Red Cross, was contacted by the family on March 23 in time to request the serviceman's presence. The Chapter, in turn, verified the death and relayed the verification immediately to Washington, D. C., where overseas leave decisions are made. The Military replied on March 24 that the leave request was denied but that the report of the father's death was forwarded to the serv-

iceman. The Chapter gave this information to the family.

Military policy regarding emergency leaves due to death is as follows:

"All branches of the Armed Forces are authorized to grant a member leave when an emergency has arisen and granting such leave will contribute to the alleviation of the emergency. Each request is handled on an individual basis. Due to considerations of distances, cost and loss of time from military duty, each branch of the Armed Forces has established specific requirements that determine when a serviceman stationed outside the continental United States may be granted an emergency leave to return to the United States.

"Leaves may be granted in case of death of a member of the immediate family where important responsibilities are placed on the individual which must be met and which cannot be accomplished without the member's presence and which cannot be accomplished by any other individual."

Leaves are generally denied when the request is more for the sole purpose of attending a funeral, particularly when the serviceman is overseas. When an emergency leave is granted by the Military, the Red Cross will provide the serviceman financial assistance if needed for transportation and/or other urgent needs incidental to his emergency leave. The family always has the right to request emergency leave and the Red Cross stands ready 24 hours per day to forward the necessary verification.
