Terrier Wins Top Prize In Del-Otse-Nango Show

A skye terrier—twice as long as a Scotty with hair hanging over his eyes and straight to the ground—won the best-in-show at the Del-Otse-Nango Kennel Club 11th show here on Sunday.

The terrier's name — Champion Rhosneigel Rising Star of Iradell of the Iradell Kennels in Richfield, Conn.

Harold Keen, secretary-treasurer of the local club, said there were 311 entries from several parts of the United States and Canada.

He noted that this was the first show in America in which the

Australian terrier was allowed to compete. The breed has just been recognized by the American Kennel Club, he said.

Ten were entered in the show at Neahwa Park.

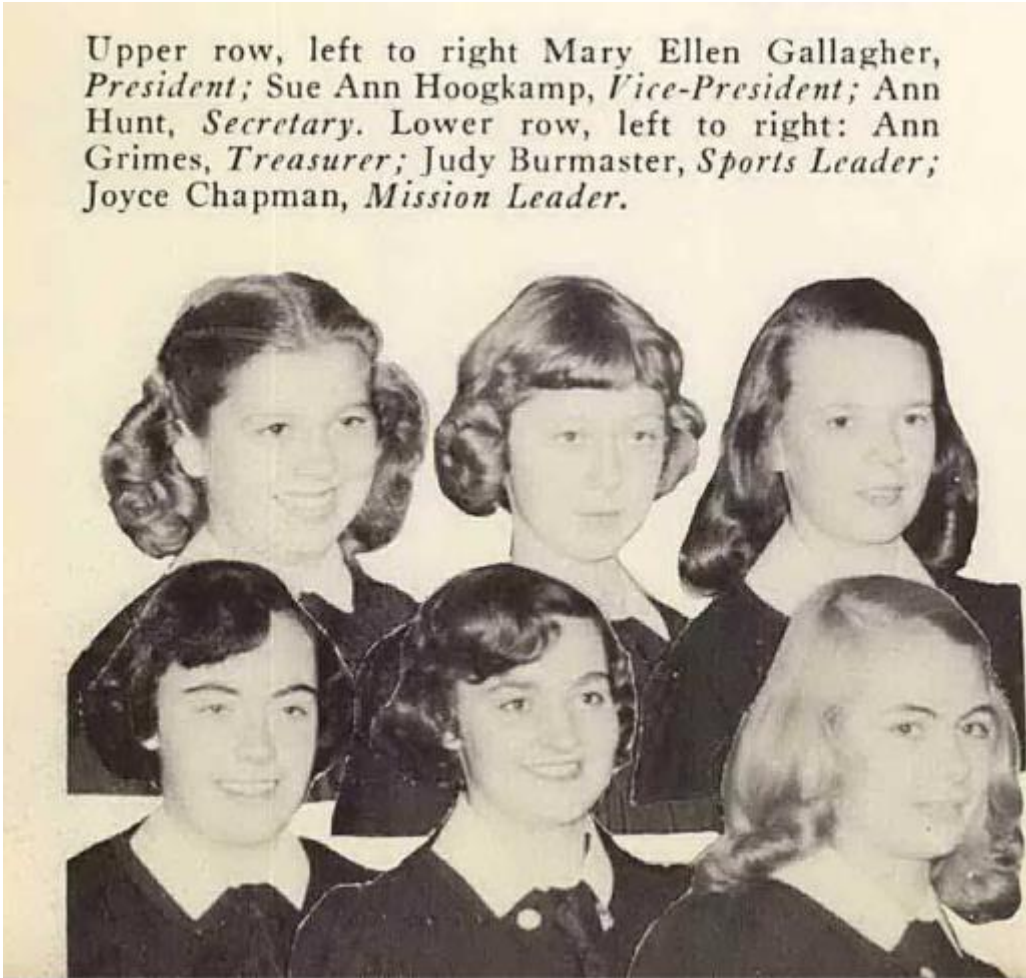

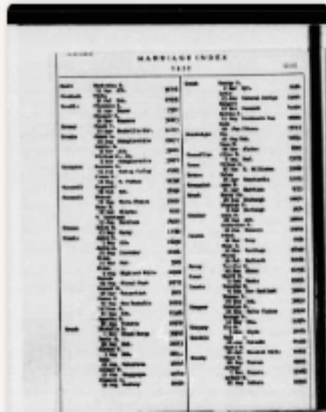

Albany:—Three men seeking to arouse what they supposed was a dozing motorist, found William H. Chapman, slate beverage tax examiner, dead at the wheel of his car.

As they drove along Blessing Road early Sunday morning, Samuel and Trumain Barker and Arthur Rhodes of Slingers, en route to Sacandaga Reservoir to fish, saw Chapman slumped down in his seat. The car was standing slightly off the road a mile from the Slingerlands Road.

When they shook him, it was apparent the 31-year-old state employe was dead. The men notified Constable Edward A. Wogatake, who, in turn, called Coroner E. A. Helu. Dr. John J. Phelau, coroner's physician, was directed to perform an autopsy to determine if the cause of death was carbon monoxide. The body was taken to the undertaking rooms of Marshall Tebbutt's Sons.

Mr. Chapman was born in North Blenheim, Schoharie county, Sept. 30, 1901, the son of Frank A. and Elizabeth Rose Chapman, who survive him. For two months in 1928, he was a member of the Division of State Police. He lived at 606 Delaware Avenue.

"Rochester (NY) Democrat & Chronicle" 8 Jan 1940 p 1 – Frank Chapman, 38 [sic], Middleburg, died in the Albany Hospital 7 Jan of burns from a fire caused by smoking in bed.

"Ithaca (NY) Journal" 10 Jan 1940 p 14 – Middleburg: Frank Chapman, 68, retired inn proprietor, died because of smoking in bed. He died of burns a few hours after a neighbor dragged him from his blazing mattress Sunday.

Lucile was the daughter of John Alexander Cromie (1884-1974, F: 172117733) & Minerva Hannah Parsons (1883 - d. 9 Oct 1976 Altamont CA, F: 172117734). At the time of William's death in Sep 1936, his father-in-law John A. Cromie was the assistant director of administration, NY State Tax Department. - Had served for 2 months in the NY state police in 1929. Then became the state's beverage tax examiner. He was found dead slumped at the wheel of his car on Blessing Road, one mile from New Scotland Road, by passing motorists. Newspaper articles found online report that an investigation was to be undertaken but no results were posted online. – In the 1950 census for Albany, Albany NY, John A. Cromie, 66 NY, was retired. In his household were wife Minnie H. (66 NY) daughter Lucille [sic] Chapman, 40 NY, a clerk in the state department of taxation & insurance, whose status is "married" and her daughter, Joan Chapman, 14 NY. - Buried in Graceland Cemetery, Albany, Albany NY. F: 172116964

On Find A Grave record: retired owner, Chapman Automotive Service Station, located at Madison Ave. & Lark St. for over 44 years. Moved to Albany at age 8. Enlisted in Army at Fort Ethan Allen on 7 Jun 1917. Assigned to 2nd Cavalry Supply Train until 17 Jul 1917, then transferred to 100th Aero Squadron, 18 Jul 1917 to 9 Jun 1919. Promoted to wagoner 12 Jun 1917, to private 13 Oct 1917. Dog enthusiast; taught weekly dog obedience classes. Raised German shorthair pointers; chairman of several dog shows. Member Fort Orange Post No. 30 American Legion. Died in St. Peter's Hospital, Albany, after short illness.

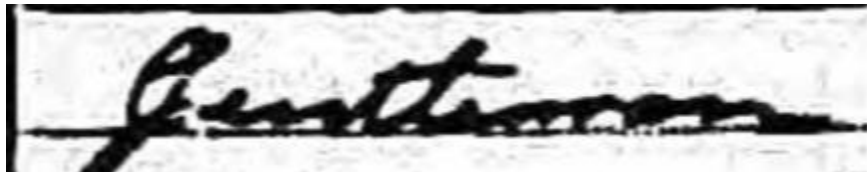
