To Mt. Vernon Signal: — The death of little Beulah Hibbard. Beulah, the fourteen months old daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Hiram Hibbard, died on East 11th St., Friday, July 11, at ten minutes to eleven o'clock. She suffered two days with a burn. Her death was a sudden shock to her family. The child was playing around the stove on which her mother was baking, when she pitched forward, falling with both palms against the red hot stove. Both hands were severely burned and the shock to the child was so great that she never revived. The funeral services were held Saturday afternoon at Grand Center. The child was a granddaughter of Mr. and Mrs. G. R. Reams. Mr. Hibbard lived at Dudley, Ky., several years. From there he moved to Laurel county, then in August 1918, he moved to Trenton, Mo., where he has since lived.
