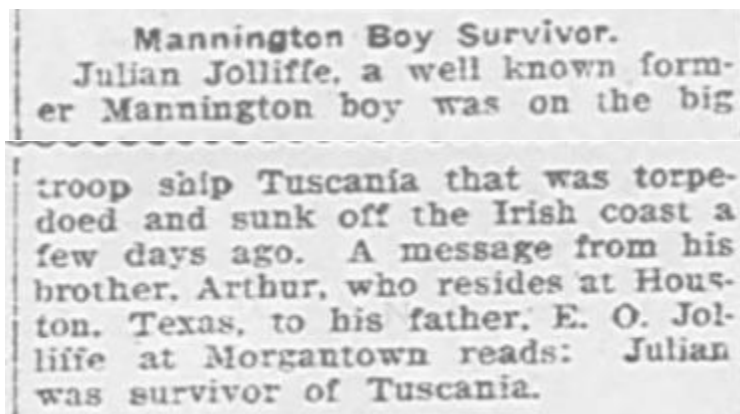

FORMER FAIRMONT MAN DIES IN MORGANTOWN

Ethebert O. Jolliffe, 65 years old, died Saturday night at the home of his mother, Mrs. O. P. Jolliff, 838 Bridge street, Morgantown, after a long and lingering illness of paralysis. He was the eldest son of Capt. and Mrs. O. P. Jolliffe and was a resident of this city several years ago. His father died just one year ago. His mother, six brothers and one sister, namely Charles, George William, Melville, Joseph and Frank Jolliffe and Mrs. Frank Gapp of Morgantown, survive him. Three children also survive, Arthur and Ruth of Houston, Tex., and Julian of Columbus, Ohio.

No time has yet been decided upon for the funeral service, pending the arrival of his son Arthur from Houston, Tex. Burial will be made at Mt. Calvary M. P. Church near Ridgedale, Monongalia County.
