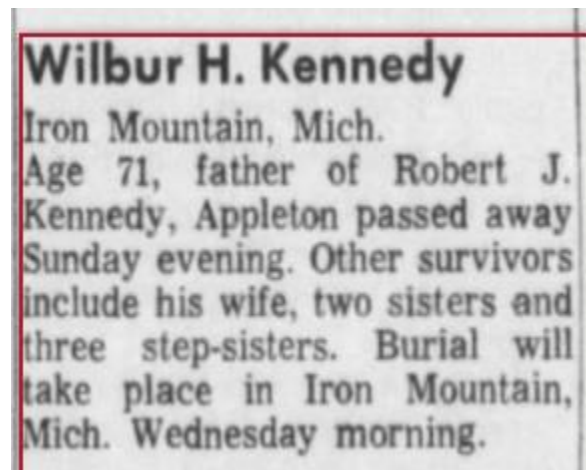

Robert J. Kennedy, 84, Appleton, passed away Friday, Dec. 22, 2006, at Cherry Meadows Hospice. Bob was born Sept. 17, 1922, in Antigo, Wis., the son of the late Wilbur and Eleanor (Fontaine) Kennedy. He was a veteran



of WWII serving with the U.S. Marine 5th division in the Pacific. Bob took part in many island invasions during his tour of duty. Following his discharge, Bob enrolled at Marquette University where he graduated with a degree in business administration. He moved to Appleton in 1949 to work for the Carroll and Carroll Real Estate Co. He later owned and operated the agency under the name Kennedy Realtors for many years retiring in 1984.
