**63 AMERICANS ARE RECOVERING IN IRISH HOSPITALS
FROM INJURIES.**

**Willie P. Le Blanc of St. John
Parish and 11 Texans Are
Among the Number.**

Washington, Feb. 24.—Sixty-three American survivors of the torpedoed ship *Tuscania* were reported to the war department today as recovering in Irish hospitals from the effects of injuries or exposures. The dispatch said none of the cases was serious, and that it was expected all the men would soon be discharged.

All of the 63 had previously been reported saved, and the presence of many of them in hospitals had been recorded in press dispatches, although today's dispatch brought the first official list of those in hospitals.
