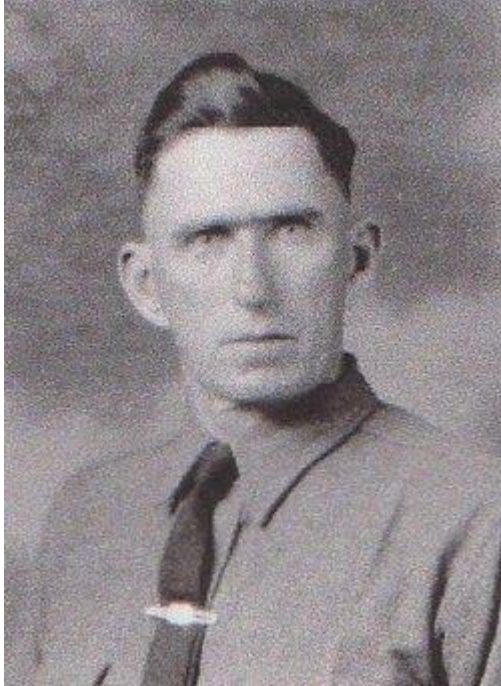

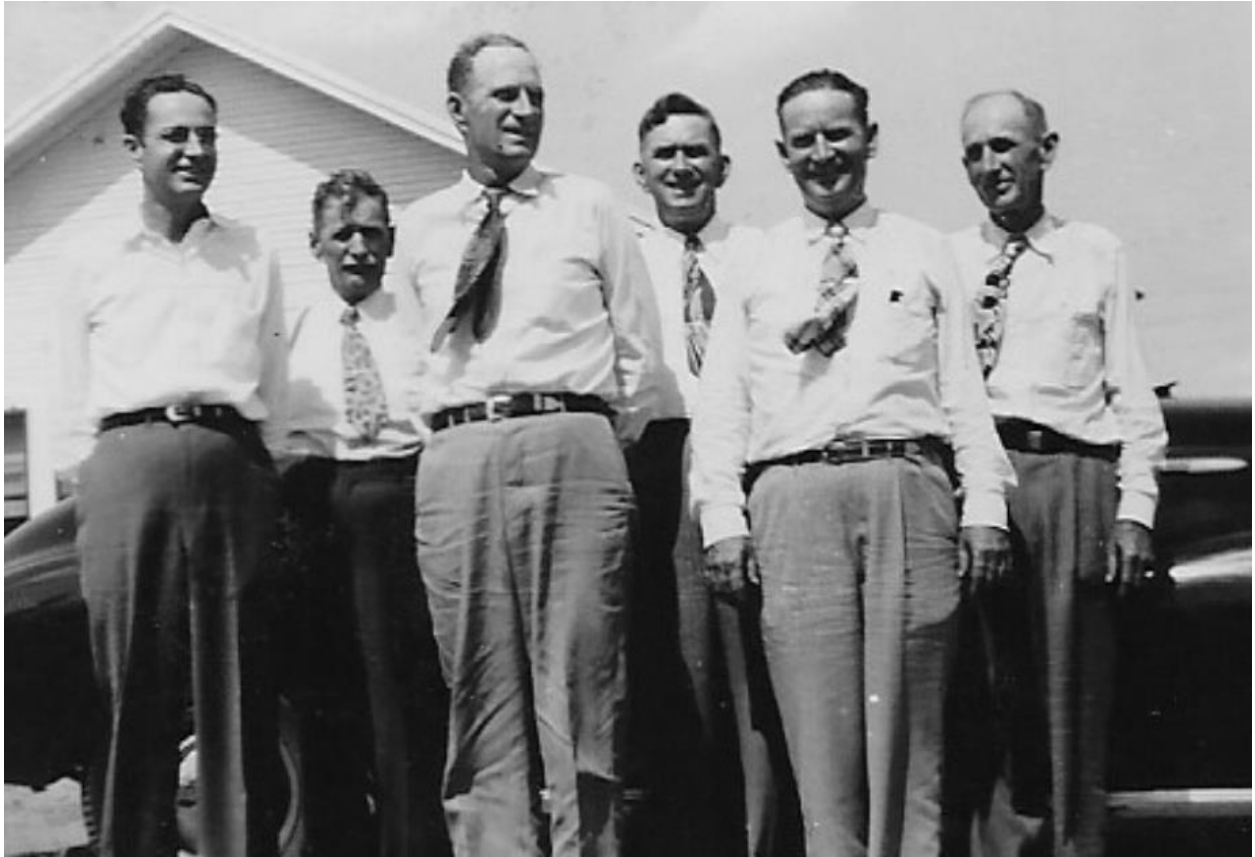

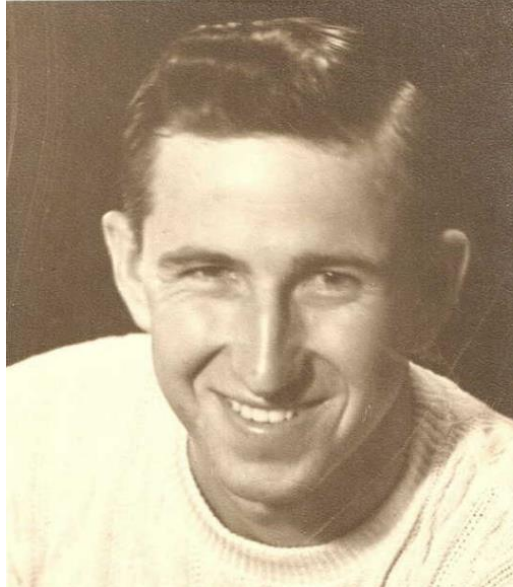

- Mamie Telula Lambert Claxton Crow, 4 Feb 1901 Simpson, Heard GA – 23 Oct 1993 Sweetwater, Nolan TX. SSN 466-48-6454. – Wife of Ben Claxton whom she married 2 Feb 1917 in Fisher Co. TX. In the 1920 census, Ben & Mamie live with their daughter with Mamie’s parents & siblings. (See below, in Census) Believe him to be Ben Wesley Claxton (1894 TX – 1983 TX, buried in Belvieu Cemetery, Rotan, Fisher TX, F: 112778119)- although he claimed to be single when he registered for the WWI draft on 5 Jun 1917. - Wife of Jesse Wyatt Crow (1892-1969). In the 1930 census lives with husband Jesse Crow & Claxton & Crow children (see below, in Census). Listed as Mrs. Jess Crow in Marion’s obituary in Nov 1962. – Her husband Jesse Wyatt Crow was the son of David Ollie Crow & Florence Hodges. His daughter Florence Edith Crow by his 1st wife, Corine Kay McCann, married Mamie’s brother Jesse Lloyd Lambert. So Mamie’s stepdaughter Florence was also her daughter-in-law. - Died at the Roscoe Nursing Center. Survived by 4 sons & 4 daughters.
- William Charlie (W.C.) Lambert, 13 Nov 1903 Texas (or Simpson), Heard Co. GA – 11 Apr 1980 Aspermont, Stonewall TX. Husband of Gladys Bertha Couch (1903-1978) whom he married 12 Jan 1924 in Roby, Fisher TX. Buried in Aspermont Cemetery, Stonewall TX. F: 79869516

- James Homer Lambert, 23 Jun 1906 Simpson, Heard GA – 28 May 1907 Simpson, Heard GA.
- Alice Elizabeth Lambert Bigham, 12 Mar 1908 GA – 13 Oct 1979. Wife of Barnette (“Barney”) Bigham (1892-1971) whom she married 3 Mar 1925 in Roby, Fisher TX. Listed as Mrs. Barney Bigham in brother Marion’s Nov 1962 obituary. Buried in Belvieu Cemetery, Rotan, Fisher TX. F: 68133877
- Jesse Lloyd Lambert, 3 Jan 1912 Rosebud, Falls TX – 4 Jan 1970 Fort Worth, Tarrant TX. Was an aircraft production controller. Husband of Florence Edith Crow (1915-2008). Florence was the daughter of Jesse’s sister Mamie Lambert Claxton Crow’s husband Jesse Wyatt Crow by his 1st wife, Corine Kay McCann, daughter of Michael McCann & Ida Beulah Curlee. Corine later married John L. Jolly. – Jesse is buried in Mount Olivet Cemetery, Fort Worth, Tarrant TX. F; 90150543

Pre-war:

Wartime:

According to a family story, Marion’s wife Pearl Noles Lambert was supposedly contacted by the War Department via telegram that Marion had died in the sinking of “Tuscania.” Then she began getting mail from him from France. Pearl supposedly called the War Department to find out why she had been told he was dead. Within 24 hours, the War Department contacted her to confirm Marion was alive and in France.

According to his family, Marion received a serious head injury in the sinking of the Tuscania, which affected his health throughout his life.

“Fort Worth (TX) Star-Telegram” Monday 11 Feb 1918 p 7 – as yet unaccounted for from Tuscania: from the Replacement Detachment, Camp Travis – Marion F. Lambert of Rotan TX.

“Fort Worth (TX) Star-Telegram” Sunday 17 Feb 1918 p 4 – on Saturday night the War Department added the names of 18 more survivors, one of them being Marion F. Lambert of Rotan TX.

Post-war:

Marion was a cotton farmer until 1935. From 8 Jan 1935 to July 1936, he worked in the US Civilian Conservation Corps, doing park improvement in Sweetwater Canyon & Lubbock TX.

His children recalled that following their mother Pearl’s death in 1933, they were sent to live with various relatives. Their father Marion gathered them up after he married Edna Tumlinson in 1936.

He later owned a grocery store, worked for the railroad, owned a flour mill, worked as a carpenter and owned restaurants, including one made out of an old railroad car (according to the family, in Baytown TX). He was also a lay preacher for the Church of Christ.

He also served as Fisher Co. TX sheriff for one term. According to his son William Elvis Lambert, he was not re-elected because he was opposed to the Ku Klux Klan and the Baptists.

In addition to a military pension, the family believes he was supported by the work of his second wife, Edna Tumlinson Lambert, who was a schoolteacher in a rural school. As late as 1946 or 1947, his home did not have electricity but used kerosene lamps for lighting.

His grandchildren remembered his piercing eyes and that he was tall, with a "thick Texas drawl."

After the failure of his diner, Marion & Edna moved to San Antonio TX for the last decade of his life, where Edna taught school in a poor Hispanic section of town, as she was fluent in English and Spanish. During the last 7 years of his life, Marion had poor health & was hospitalized intermittently. Marion suffered a stroke in 1957, and spent some time in the state mental hospital. After his stroke, Marion was unaware of his surroundings. His TX death certificate mentions chronic brain syndrome & psychotic reactions.

"Abilene [TX] Reporter-News" 12 Nov 1962 p 40, age 68, former Fisher County TX resident. Funeral 12 Nov 1962 at San Antonio & 13 Nov 1962 at Rotan Church of Christ, with burial in Sardis Cemetery SW of Rotan. Born 28 (?) Nov 1893 Franklin Co. (?) GA, son of Mr. & Mrs. W.A. Lambert, who later settled in Fisher Co. TX. Farmed in Fisher Co. 1913-19335, operated a grocery store for a short time. Married Pearl Noles 1917; she died 1932. Married Edna Tumblinson in Lubbock TX 1936. WWI veteran. Survived by wife Edna, 2 sons, 2 daughters, 5 brothers, 3 sisters.
