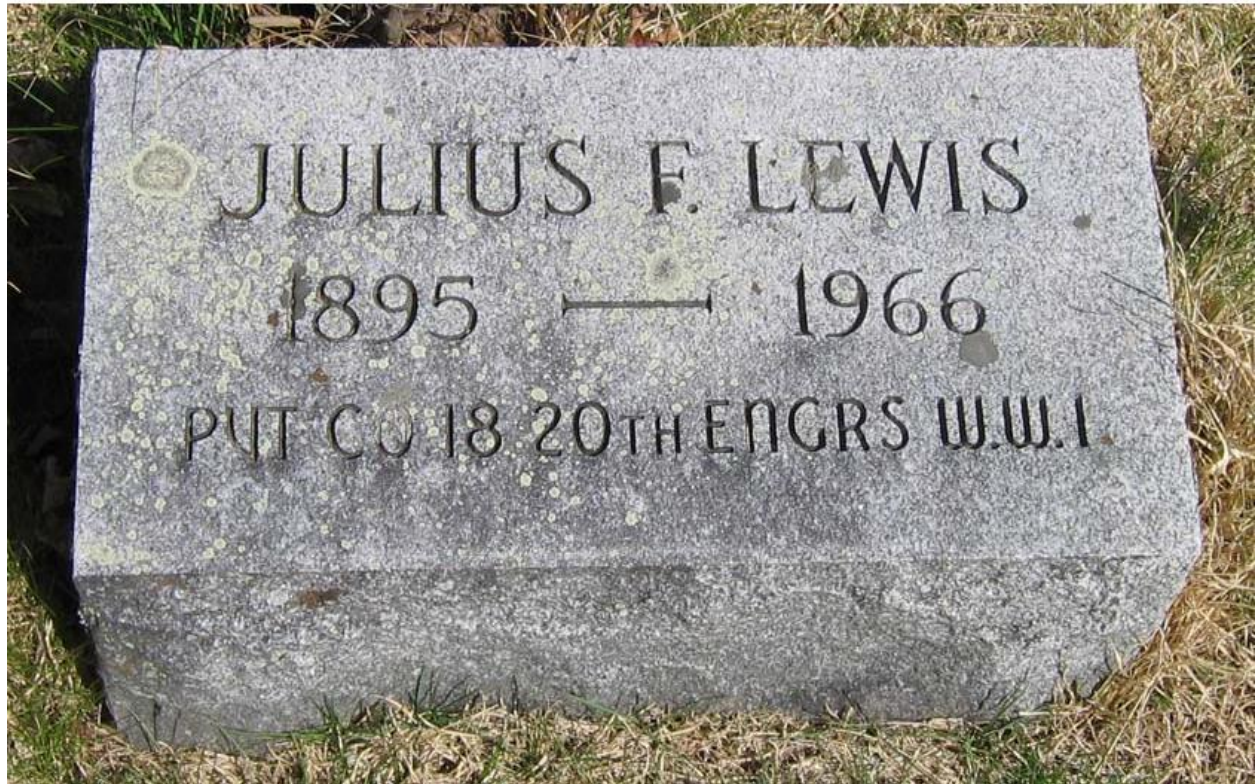

WILLIAMSPORT, Pa., Feb. 11.—Four Lycoming county soldiers who were on board the Tuscania are in Irish ports. All have cabled their parents that they were safe. Following receipt of a cablegram from Lieutenant Eugene A. Kane, of this city by his parents, cables came yesterday from Corporal Bruce Woolover, of Montoursville; Private Howard C. Harris, of Waterville, and Private Julius Lewis, of Barbours. Lewis is in a hospital suffering from the effects of his experience, while the others have recovered and are ready for immediate duty.

## TUSCANIA SURVIVORS IN IRISH HOSPITALS

(By International News Service.)

WASHINGTON, Feb. 24.— Sixty-three survivors of the transport Tuscania, sunk by a German submarine February 5, still are in British hospitals, according to a cable report announced by the War Department tonight. None of the men is in a serious condition, and it is expected that all of them will be discharged from the hospital within a short time.

Forty of the wounded and sick men are at Londonery, 19 at Larby, 3 at Belfast, and 1 at Dublin.

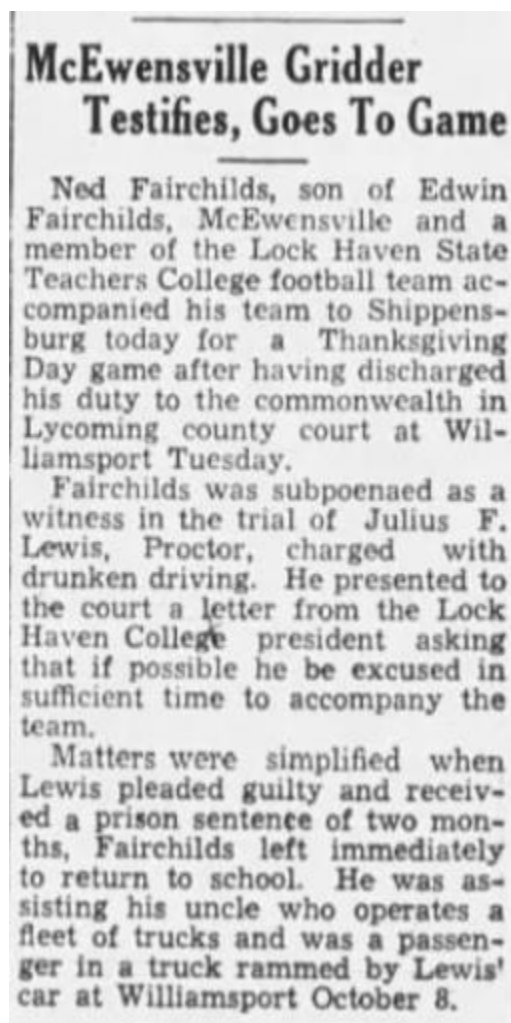
Divorce:

## Patient Captured After Breaking Door To Flee

Julius F. Lewis, of Lycoming county, who disappeared from the Danville State hospital yesterday morning, was apprehended in a wood about a half mile from the diagnostic clinic yesterday afternoon by hospital attaches and state motor police of the Bloomsburg detail. A homicidal patient, he broke open a door at the hospital to make his getaway at 10 a. m.

A police teletype message was broadcast asking for his apprehension. It was believed he would go to the home of his father and brothers, on Proctor star route, Williamsport R. D.

Lewis is 46 years of age and has a persecution complex, police said.
