Escapes From Tuscania Without Wetting His Feet

Young Forestry Engineer
Writes Home of His Experi-
ences When the Transport
Went Down.

Pertle F. Linder of Indian Valley, Idaho, who enlisted with the forestry engineers in Boise December 12, was on board the Tuscania when she was torpedoed off the coast of Ireland and escaped without so much as getting his feet wet.

In a brief letter to his mother telling of the incident, he says:

"If this is allowed to go through, I will tell you I was on board the Tuscania. I suppose you have read about it being torpedoed. Well, I got away without even getting my feet wet. I lost most all my equipment in the boat. I got out with my complete uniform, minus the hat. I kept my overcoat, too. I was picked up by a torpedo boat destroyer two hours after the boat was hit.

"If they had all stayed on the boat the loss would have been nearly nothing. I will tell you all about it some time."

"Pert," as his folks at home know him, quite modestly tells in his letter how he and another chap took care of a sick comrade and succeeded in getting him safely off the Tuscania and on board the destroyer.

"I didn't see the submarine," he writes. "Tell Dowd I am in the country where he used to live. I heard that our ship sank about four hours after she was hit."

Young Linder is a member of F company, Battalion 6, 20th regiment. He wrote from Shane's Park camp, Belfast, Ireland.

IDAHO PIONEER CLOSES CAREER

James Linder, 80, Former
Adams County Legislator,
Succumbs in Boise

James I. Linder, 80, of Indian Valley, pioneer Idahoan and former state legislator, died at a Boise hospital Saturday. He had been visiting his daughter, Mrs. Prudy Henke, of Boise.

Mr. Linder had lived at Indian Valley in Adams county, for 53 years, having come west from Missouri with his family by wagon train. He first settled in Boise and later lived in Middle Valley.

His term as legislator was served during Governor Alexander's time. He also served as county commissioner for Washington and Adams counties.

Mr. Linder was prominent in Odd Fellows' activities, being a charter member of the Council and Indian Valley lodges.

He is survived by seven brothers and sisters, all of whom are more than 65 years of age. They are: Mrs. Lizzie Hartley of Midvale, Mrs. Laura Fletcher of Watsonville, Cal., "Doc," Ed, Tom and Emory Linder, all of Midvale, and Will Linder of West Port, Wash. The following sons and daughters also survive: Mrs. Henke, Mrs. Agnes Gibbs of Indian Valley, Mrs. Susie Joanis of Bend, Ore., and Oliver and Perlle Linder of Indian Valley. Mr. Linder's wife died in April, 1934.

Mr. Linder's body is at the McBratney funeral home. Funeral services will be held at 2 o'clock Tuesday afternoon in Indian Valley with the Odd Fellows' lodge in charge.

Funeral Tuesday For James Linder Of Indian Valley

Funeral services for James L. Linder, 80, former Adams county legislator and an Idaho pioneer, will be held at Indian Valley Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock. He died Saturday in Boise at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Prudy Henke.

Mr. Linder lived in Indian Valley 53 years. He was with the party which buried the victims of the Long valley Indian massacre August 20, 1878.

At that time he was working on a ranch in Indian valley for William Munday, the first man killed by the Indians. The other victims were John Healy and Jake Grasclose. "Three Finger" Smith was shot in the hip but managed to crawl through the brush up Payette river and was rescued by a mail carrier at Rocky flat, near the present site of McCall.

A party of scouts and a detachment of soldiers under General Howard pursued the Indians and killed most of them.

A monument was erected August 18, 1929, on the spot of the massacre by the society of the Sons of Idaho. Mr. Linder attended the dedication and was one of three survivors of the scout party present.

Mr. Linder is survived by seven brothers and sisters, all of whom are more than 65 years of age, also three daughters and two sons. The body is at the McBratney funeral home in Boise. Flowers may be delivered to the funeral home until Monday evening.
