Leonard S. Cairns Is Dead of Pneumonia

**Malady Caused by Influenza
Takes Life of Former Street
Railway Official.**

Leonard S. Cairns, formerly general superintendent of the Minneapolis Street Railway company and nearly all his life a Minneapolitan, died yesterday in Pottsville, Pa., where he was general manager of the Eastern Pennsylvania Railways company. Death was caused by pneumonia resulting from influenza.

Mr. Cairns was 37 years old and until 1912 lived from babyhood in this city, growing up in the organization of the street railway company. He left here in 1912 to become general manager of the Manila Electric Railway and Light company, a property of the J. G. White company of New York. He remained in the Philippines five years and then returned to the United States to the position in Pottsville with the White company.

Mr. Cairns is survived by his wife and two children, all of whom are ill with influenza; by his mother, Mrs. E. J. Cairns of 1517 Franklin avenue west; a sister and two brothers, one of whom is in the service at Dallas, Texas. It is expected the funeral will take place in Minneapolis Monday or Tuesday.

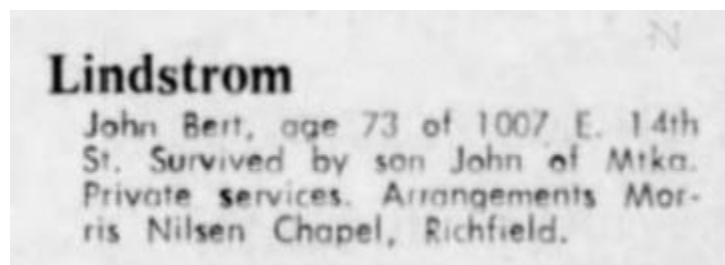

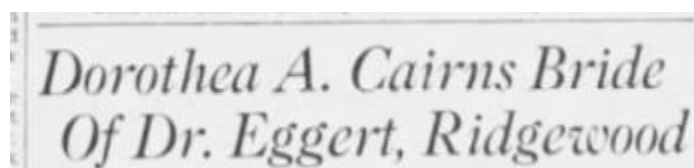
