## DIVORCE DECREE SOUGHT BY WIFE

**Stella Mae Hall Seeks Freedom From Ernest Hall,  
Alleging Cruelty.**

Allegations of extreme cruelty are contained in the complaint filed in the district court yesterday in which Stella Mae Hall asks a decree of divorce from Ernest Victor Hall. The couple were married in Liberal, Kan., on Sept. 19, 1922, and have no children.

Hall is charged with making repeated threats to bodily injure his wife, who alleges that she lives in constant fear of him. On several occasions he is alleged to have choked and threatened to kill the plaintiff and to have cursed and abused her. A decree of divorce is all the wife asks.

Believe this is Earnest Victor Hall, 17 Aug 1886 Maple City, Cowley KS – 11 Jun 1957 Beaver, Beaver Co. OK, buried in Beaver Pioneer Cemetery, Beaver, Beaver OK, F: 69386888, the son of Levi Woodbury Hall & Almira Meek.
