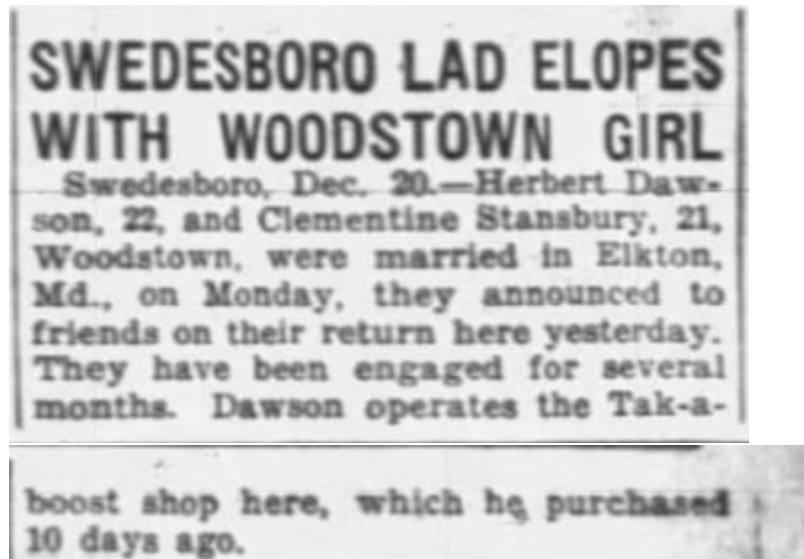
A lifetime resident of Salem County, she was a member of Trinity United Methodist Church of Pennsville and of the church prayer group. She was also a member of the Ladies Auxiliary of Salem County Memorial Hospital.

Mrs. Logan was the widow of Ruben G. Logan, who died in 1960. She was preceded in death by her only daughter about a year ago. She is survived by a grandchild and three great-grandchildren.

When he registered for the WWII draft (1942), he resided on Marlton St., Woodstown, Salem NJ. He worked for E.I. Du Pont in Deepwater NJ. His NOK was Mrs. Clementine Dawson (his daughter).

Harriet is buried in Lawnside Cemetery, Woodstown, Salem NJ.

Clementine was a senior at Swedesboro High School in 1926 when she went on a 3-day class trip to Washington DC ("Camden [NJ] Courier-Post" Saturday 15 May 1926 p 3). She eloped with Herbert, to whom she had been engaged for a few months, and they got married 16 Dec 1929 in Elkton, Cecil MD. She died 1 year before her mother. Buried in Lawnside Cemetery, Woodstown, Salem NJ. F: 147413988

Siblings: His mother reported in the 1900 census that she had given birth to 7 children, but only had 1 living (Reuben). In the 1910 census, she says she has given birth to 2 children, 2 of whom (Reuben & Pansy) are living.
