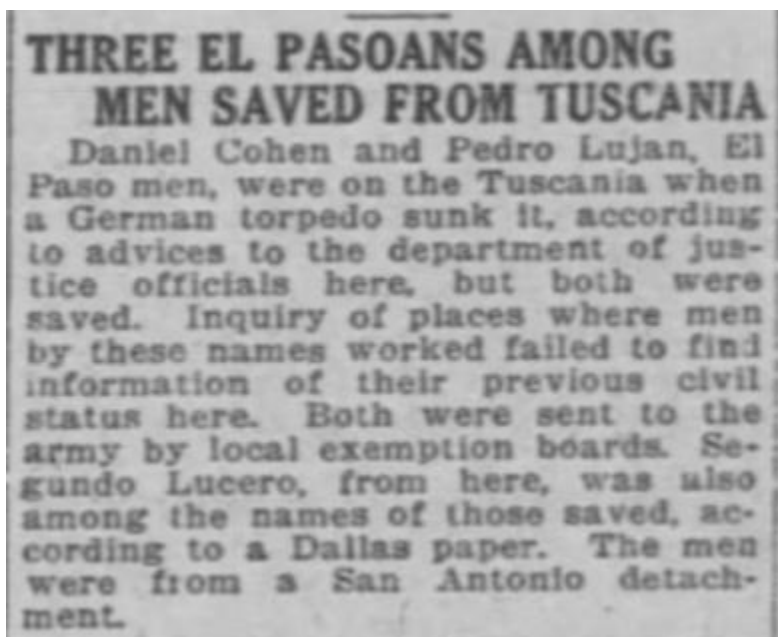

DOS INDIVIDUOS SE SALVARON DE LA CATASTROFE

Danny Cohen, el primero que fue aprehendido aquí por "slacker" y Pedro Luján, por lo mismo se hallaban en el "Tuscania," pero se salvaron.

Danny Cohen, al primer individuo aprehendido en El Paso por las autoridades, debido a que se negó a cumplir con los reglamentos sobre el servicio militar selectivo, y fue dado de alta en el ejército, iba en el "Tuscania", cuando éste fue torpedeado, según noticias llegadas últimamente a esta ciudad, y logró salvarse. Pedro Luján, el tercero que sufrió al arresto por igual razón que

Cohen, iba igualmente a bordo del "Tuscania", y se salvó.

Estos individuos, después de las audiencias de rigor, no pudieron probar que estaban exentos del servicio y han resultado buenos soldados, según informan sus superiores. Los padres de ambos residen en esta ciudad.

Otro individuo aprehendido por no contestar el cuestionario, tuvo dos caminos para escoger: un año de prisión y pase a las filas después, o pase inmediato a las filas. Optó por lo segundo.

Con la misma rapidez y energía con que se está procediendo contra los infractores de la ley militar, se procederá contra los alemanes que no se registraron a tiempo, y se les internará en el acto.

“El Paso (TX) Times” Tuesday 14 Aug 1917 p 2 – men called to draft on 16 Aug include #1351 – 504 Pedro Lujan, 219 – 8th (but this man’s WWI draft card says he was born 30 Oct 1886 in Carmago, Chihuahua, Mexico)

“Houston (TX) Post” Sunday 2 Dec 1917 p 21 – news from Camp Travis TX – the charge of desertion, entered for men who failed to report to military duty, has been set aside as erroneous for a long list of men, who are all in the Depot Brigade. Pedro Lujan is listed; other names recognized as Tuscania passengers are Cruz Martinez, Margarita Macias & Sixto Flores.

“Fort Worth (TX) Star-Telegram” 10 Feb 1918 p 1 – among the Tuscania survivors: Lujan, Pedro, El Paso TX.
