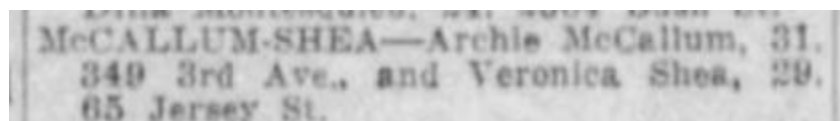

Radio Advised Officers Jail Car Theft Suspect

PITTSBURG, July 9.—(UP)—The Contra Costa County officers took pride today in the fact they keep their ears glued to the radio. Within an hour and eight minutes after they heard the alarm, they apprehended a Stockton man wanted as an auto thief.

William J. Miller of San Francisco, who gave his residence as the Stockton State Hospital, was accused of stealing an automobile in Stockton at 6:30 o'clock last night. The state highway police in Sacramento broadcast his description and that of the automobile at 8:50 P. M.

At 9:18 P. M., a man answering the description of Miller held up a gasoline station at Concord and at 9:58 P. M. he was arrested as he attempted to go through a barricade on the county line at Dublin. He was booked on suspicion of grand theft.
