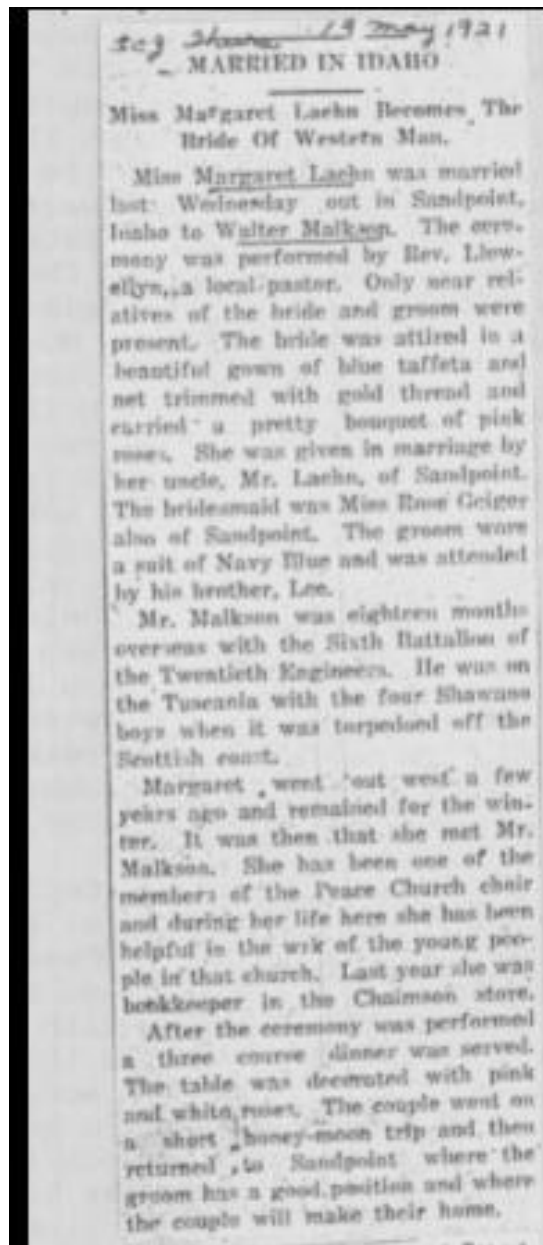

Born in Germany, Aug. 1, 1876, he came to this country with his parents at the age of 10, living in Appleton before moving to Antigo in 1885. He married the former Mathilda Dumke Oct. 19, 1898, and worked as a carpenter for his father until 1900. He later was employed by the Wisconsin Northern railroad as superintendent of bridges and buildings, and after a period of eight years, for the Soo Line railroad. After coming to Shawano he was manager of the Laehn Wood and Coal company. The deceased was a former alderman, chairman of the board of trustees of the First National bank, secretary of the Peace church for 23 years, member of the Chamber of Commerce and of the Masonic lodge.

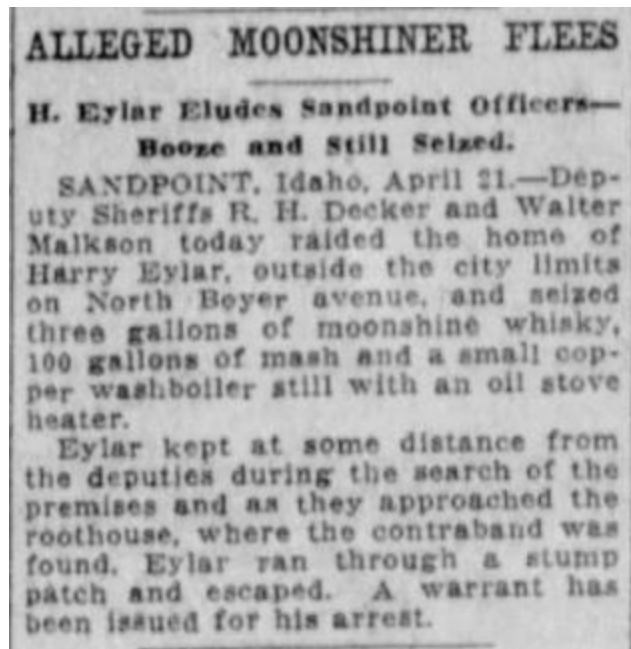

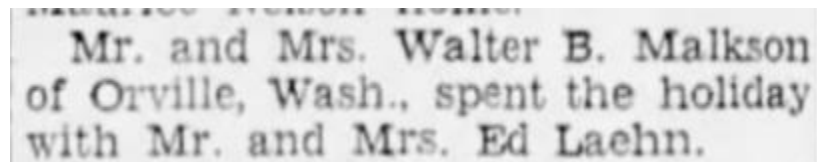
