Mine Accidents

The Editor:

Sir—Accepting the invitation in your issue of October 9 to discuss the question of accidents in mines and their causes, I offer for consideration the following statistics of fatal accidents or casualties in the mines of Houghton county, Michigan, for the year ending September 30, 1915. The mines in which fatal accidents occurred during the year in question are the Quincy, Champion, Trimountain, Baltie, Hecla Branch, South Hecla Branch, Calumet, Red Jacket Shaft, Isle Royale, Superior, Centennial, and Hecla Amygdaloid.

With a total of 16,005 men employed, only 34 casualties occurred, showing a proportion of casualties of 0.0021. Classifying the fatalities according to occupation, we have 11 miners, 6 timber-men, 10 trammers, 3 track-men, one shift-boss, one shaft-boss, one sprinkler, and one roller-fixer, and according to nature of accident: falls of rock 24, struck by skip 4, struck by timber 2, drilled into missed hole 1, fell in chute 1, fell off skip 1, and struck by car 1.

I have read carefully the testimony of witnesses and the verdict of the jury in each of the 34 cases, as stated in the county mine-inspector's report. In only 8 cases out of the total of 34 can the accident be clearly attributed to carelessness on the part of the men killed. Four of these were cases of men being struck by the skip; one case was that of a man who fell off the skip; in another case the man fell in a chute; in another a miner drilled into a missed hole. Only one case of fall of rock can be stated as due to carelessness. In these 8 cases of apparent carelessness only 2 miners were killed, the others being timber-men, trammers, and men doing minor jobs underground.

Accidents from fall of rock appear to be the most numerous, 24 of the 34 being of this nature. The question then is, are these falls of rock due to carelessness on the part of the men? In 9 of these 24 cases miners were killed and in 2 other cases a shift-boss and a shaft-boss were the unfortunate ones. All of these men were probably experienced underground men. In 10 of these cases the verdict of the jury was that death was caused by the accidental falling of loose rock. In nearly all of the 24 cases witnesses stated that the ground looked per-

fectly safe, in many cases had actually been tested, and that they were willing to work in those places where the accidents occurred. In two of the cases considered under 'fall of rock' death was due to pneumonia indirectly caused by injuries.

Since some may question my ability to judge properly a case of fall of rock, let us consider one or two cases in detail. Capt. William Jolly and Supt. Mendelsohn went into the 17th south stope on Wednesday April 28, and found a miner back about 12 ft. from the breast, which he had just drilled. No blasting had been done since the Thursday previous. Mr. Jolly called the miner and told him to bar down some loose rock. The miner could see no reason for doing this, since no one was working there. However, Mr. Jolly told him to bar it down anyway. Mr. Jolly then walked toward the hanging, when some rock fell causing his death. The jury rendered a verdict of accidental death.

Capt. John Mitchell walked up the stope to where some men were charging holes. Witnesses stated that they had walked up and down in the same place all day. Mr. Mitchell had just asked the men how they were getting along when a piece fell from the hanging, causing his death. The jury reported "that Capt. John Mitchell came to his death by an accidental fall of rock while attending to his duties."

The records and statistics that I examined prove, in my opinion, that the majority of deaths in the mines of Houghton county during the year ending September 30, 1915, were not due to carelessness of the men killed.

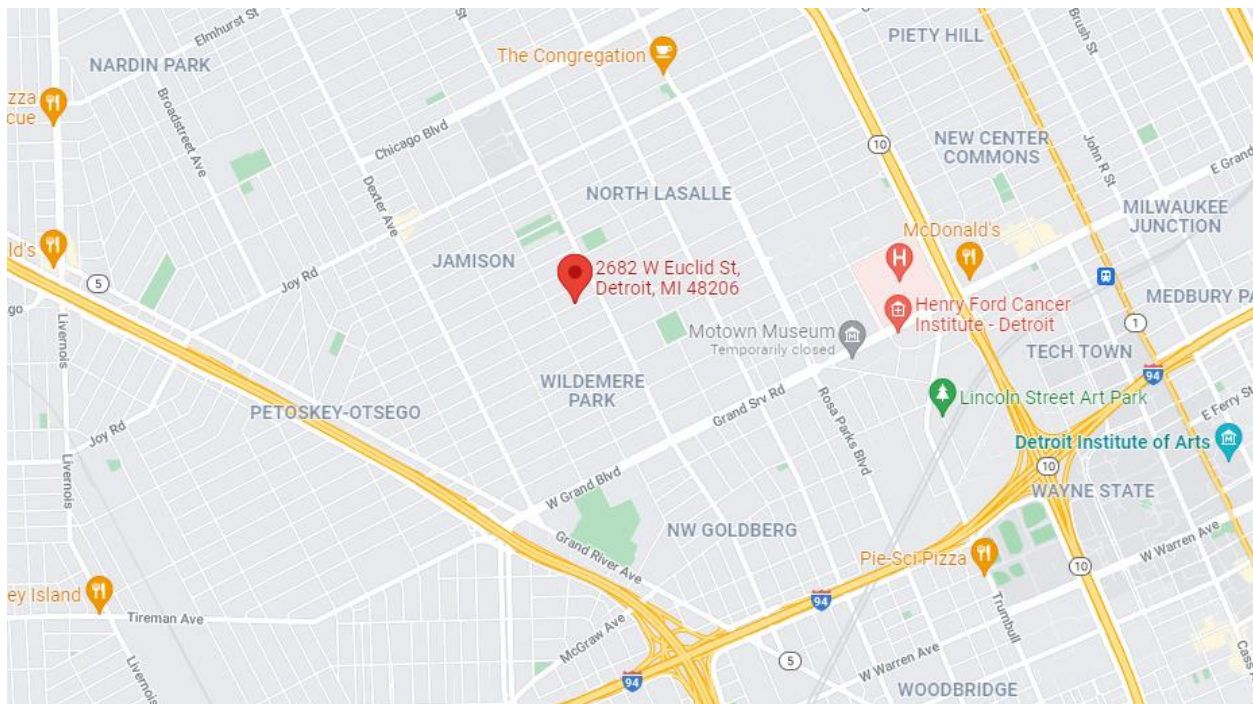
