Funeral Held For James D. Moore

Funeral services for James D. Moore were held Thursday afternoon at 2 o'clock in the Marietta Church of Christ with Bro. Monte Boren officiating.

Mr. Moore died of a heart seizure at his home here on March 3. He had been in poor health for the past four years because of a serious heart condition.

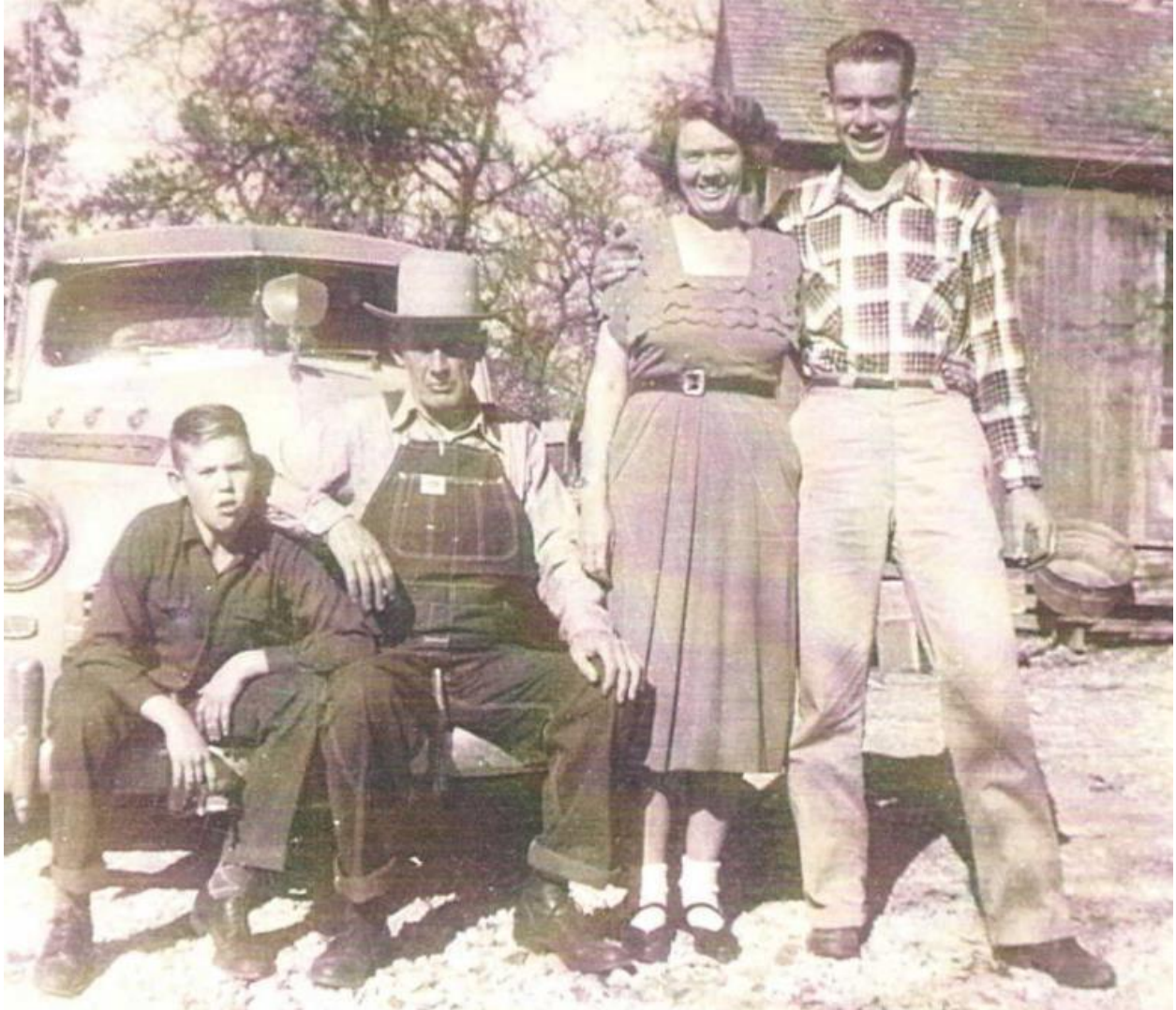
He was born near San Saba, Texas on August 31, 1885 and was married to Miss Myrtle Hughes on September 8, 1908. They were the parents of nine children. Only two survive.

He had been a resident of Love County and this area for the past 62 years having moved here in 1895. He was a long time member of the Church of Christ.

Survivors include his wife, Mrs. Myrtle Moore of Marietta; a son, A. C. Moore of Oklahoma City; a daughter, Mrs. Susie Foutch of California; two sisters, Mrs. Melissa Jones of Sentinel and Mrs. Katy Dean of Burneyville; and nine brothers, J. C. Moore of Dardanell, Ark., B. F., W. H. and C. E. Moore of Burneyville, P. H. Moore of Marietta, L. I. Moore of California, J. O. Moore of Mangum, Ed Moore of Houston and R. B. Moore of Salem, Oregon.
