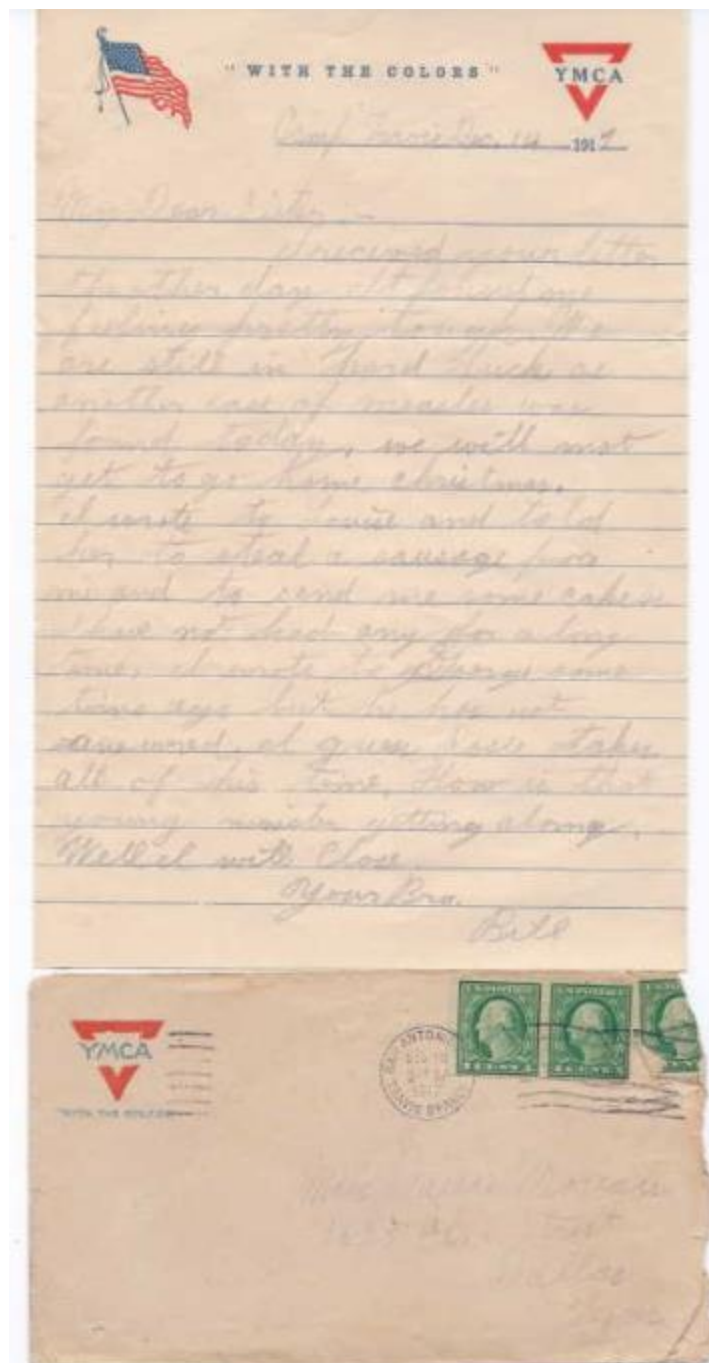

Five More Texans Included in List of Tuscania Survivors

STAFF CORRESPONDENT.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 12.—Five Texans who were on the Tuscania were removed from the unaccounted for list today, one of whom was Private Elmer Holden, Fort Worth. The other four are Robert E. Lee Hickey, Denton; William Moreau, Leon Springs; George R. Baker, Carta Valley, and Sidney R. Hall, Gainesville. Three Oklahomans, Ernest Lithicum, Oklahoma City; John Ridge, Pleasant Hill, and John F. McDonnell, Hinton, were accounted for in latest reports.

The list of missing was reduced from 339 to 328 by the checking of a number of men who were sick or injured, in hospitals in Ireland, all of whom are making satisfactory progress toward recovery.

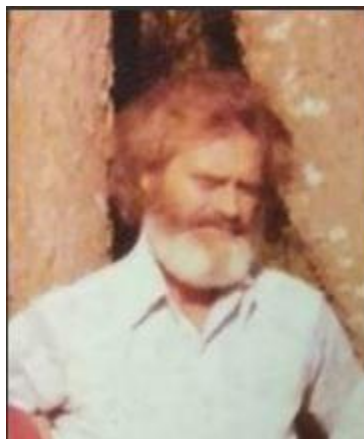

Funeral services were held Tuesday afternoon, March 21, for Herman H. Schoenert, 33, a carpenter, who was fatally injured in an automobile collision near Luling Saturday night.

Schoenert, of 401 Rrand Street, San Antonio was taken to Santa Rosa hospital in an ambulance after being given first-aid treatment at Luling. His left arm was amputated as surgeons battled for his life. He died Sunday morning at Santa Rosa Hospital.

The accident victim was a former employe of the Express Publishing Company.

Mrs. Schoenert, was a passenger in the car as was her son, Herman Jr.

The carpenter had his arm in the window and it was all but torn off by the impact.

The injured man was able to stop his machine. Passerby took him to a Luling hospital and he was later taken to San Antonio in an ambulance.

The occupant of the other car, a traveling man from Houston, was not injured.

Mrs. Schoenert was formerly Miss Bertha Meyer of Shiner.

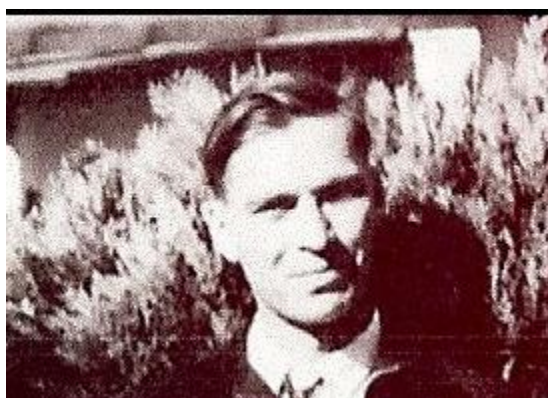
