Testimony was continued Tuesday in the habeus corpus proceedings instituted by Mary Ruth Yon against her former husband, Donald Eugene Miller, to obtain custody of a child. Miller assured Judge Klepser that he loved the child and wanted to retain custody at the home of his parents.

Miller and his former wife were married in 1952 and divorced Oct. 17, 1955, with Mrs. Yon marrying her present husband early in 1956. Testimony indicated that Miller and his former wife separated following a fire in their apartment in January, 1954. Mrs. Yon testified at the hearing Apr. 5 that she agreed to turn custody of the child over to her husband because she was destitute at the time.

Miller testified that he had earned \$30 weekly at the time his marriage broke up but that his work has improved and that he is well able to care for the child. He testified that he turns approximately \$50 weekly over to his mother for care of the child. The grandmother, Caroline Miller, testified that she had assumed the child's custody since May, 1954, and that the mother was welcome to see the child at any time.

Mrs. Yon denied testimony of Nora Smith, a former member, that she had abused the child and used profane language in its presence.

Lewistown, Feb. 14.—Albert V. Moyer of Lewistown Junction is one of the missing soldiers on the ill-fated Tuscania sunk off the Irish coast by a German submarine, early last week. He enlisted last June in the medical department of the 128th Wisconsin National Guard. He was first sent into training at Camp Douglass, Wis., and was later transferred to Waco, Tex. His regiment was in the 32d division of the U. S. Army. Government insurance was made out by the young man in behalf of his half brother and half sister, George B. Phillips of 1115 Mt. Vernon street, Philadelphia and Mrs. Cloyd B. Ritter of Lewistown Junction. He was 27

years of age.

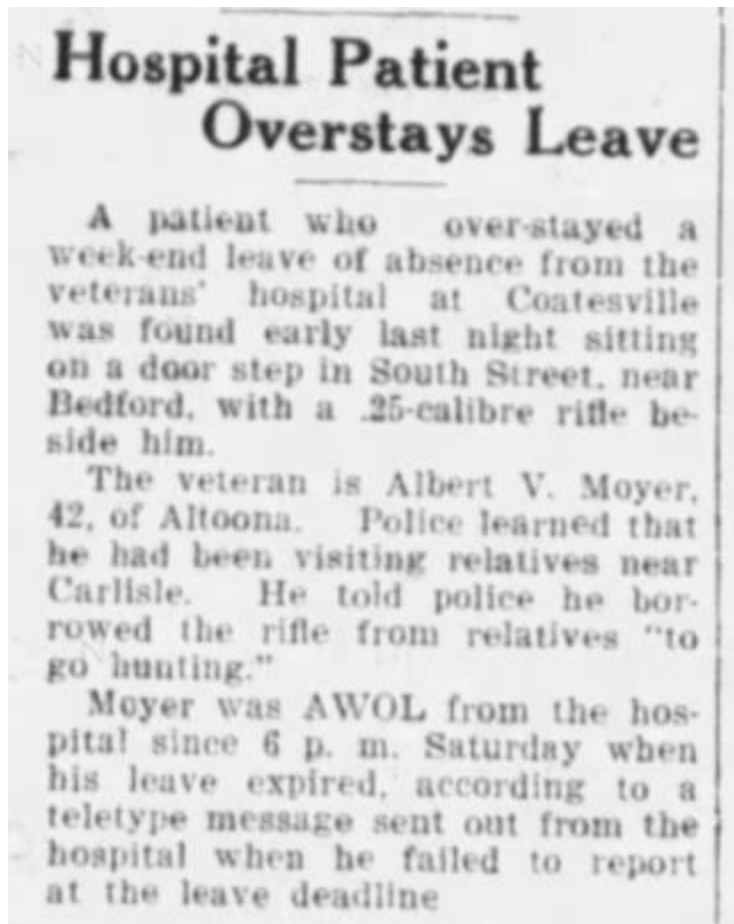

Albert V. Moyer, the first Mifflin county boy to fall in this country's clash with Teuton autocracy, lived before his enlistment with his sister, Mrs. Cloyd Ritter, at Lewistown Junction. He enlisted last June in the Medical Department of the One-hundred and Twenty-eighth Wisconsin National Guard and went to Camp Douglass, but was later transferred to Waco, Texas. He was about twenty-seven years old.

A record of a marriage between George/Allen Moyer and his mother, Lottie Haines, has not been located. Nor has Albert's birth certificate.

Albert's birthdate has been found in 1888 and 1891. Either date precedes his mother Lottie Haines's marriage to Samuel H. Phillips on 11 Jul 1891 in McClure, Snyder PA. She is listed with her birth surname of Haines. If the 1891 birthdate is correct, Albert was 5 months old when his mother married Phillips.

In the 1900 census, he is listed as Albert V. Phillips, age 9, the son of Samuel & Lottie A. Phillips. They have been married 9 years.
