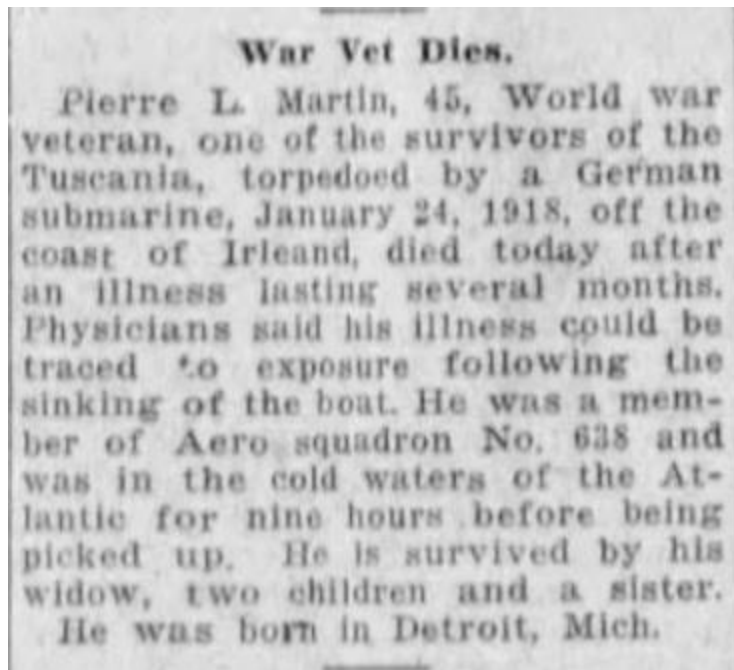

ANN McKEAN, LOCAL BUSINESS WOMAN, DIES DECEMBER 26

Ann McKean, long-time resident and business woman in Sonoma County, died in the Palm Drive Hospital December 26 after a short illness.

Mrs. McKean, 71, was the owner and operator of Ann's Dress Shop on North Main St. since last July. She fell ill the night of December 15 and was taken to the hospital for surgery on December 16. She died ten days later of a heart ailment.

A native of Ontario, the late Mrs. McKean has lived in Sonoma County for the past 30 years. For several years she was part owner of the Anna May Tea Room in Santa Rosa.

Well-known for her hearty and generous spirit, Mrs. McKean was an energetic citizen of our community. She was a past president of the Ladies' Commandery Club of Santa Rosa, past matron of the Order of the Eastern Star of Sebastopol, past president of the Sebastopol Soroptimists Club, and a member of the Wesleyan Service Guild of the Methodist Church and the Business and Professional Women's Club of Sebastopol.
