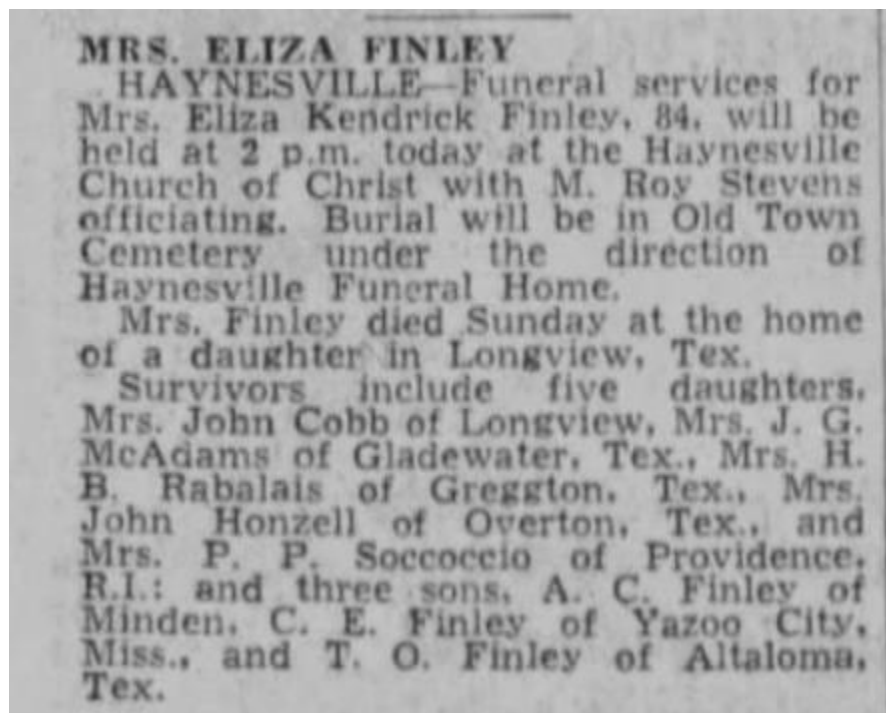

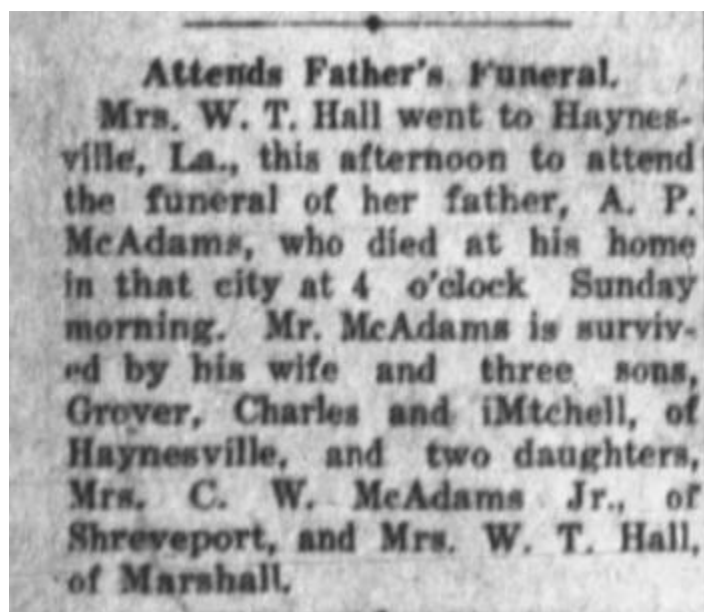


Marriage license of James Grover McAdams & Vallie Viola Finley – “Shreveport (LA) Journal” Monday 17 Aug 1936 p 5

Miss Cassandra Hall of Marshall and one sister, Mrs. Claude (Jonie) York of Marshall.

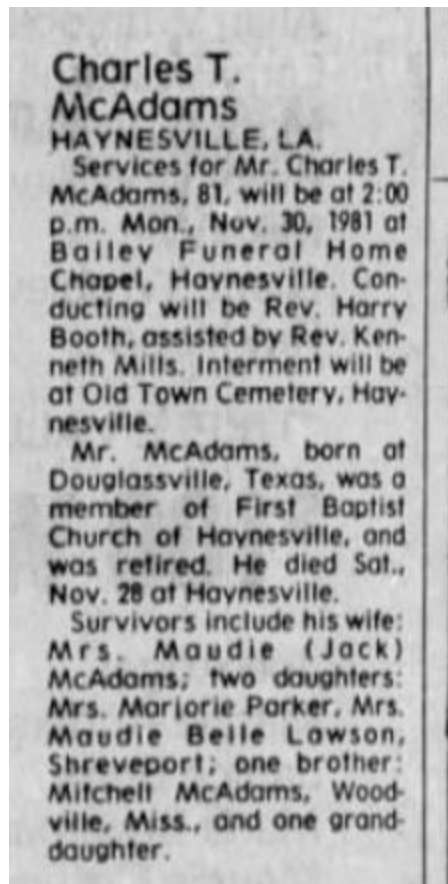

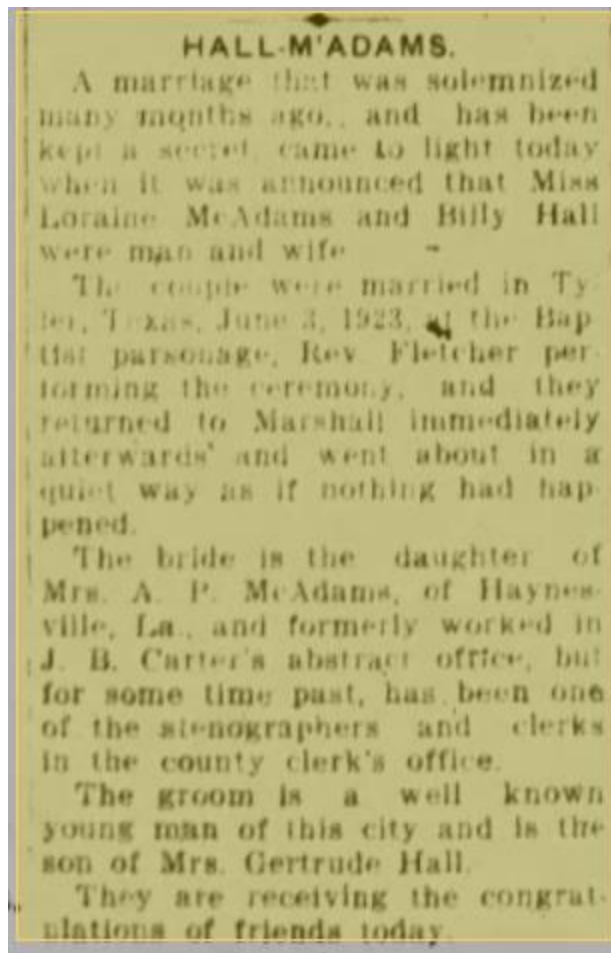

Married 16 Sep 1906 in Cass Co. TX to Joseph Harvey (“Joe”) Hammock (1883-1969, F: 86666193, who is buried with wife Noma Evelyn Fuller, 1900-1963). Died of pneumonia & heart failure, complication: measles. She is buried, according to her TX death

certificate, in Center Grove Cemetery, Red Hill, Cass TX, the same cemetery that Joseph Hammock is buried in, but she is not on Find A Grave as of 28 Oct 2021.

- Ora B. McAdams Adams, 11 Sep 1895 TX [Find A Grave says AL] – 1 Apr 1961 Tulare Co. CA. Her records are often confused with those of her sister, Era Lorene. Apparently the daughter “R.B.” listed in the 1900 census, born Sep 1895. – Married Charles Walter Adams II/Jr. (1904 LA – 1961 CA, F: 148386344). They married 14 Aug 1924 in Shreveport, Caddo Parish LA, in St. John’s Catholic Church. – In the 1930 census for Shreveport, Caddo Parish LA (conducted 12 Apr 1930), Ora Adams (claiming to be age 26, the same as her husband, but actually age 34, b. TX) lives with her husband Charles W. Adams Jr. (26 LA) & his parents, Charles W. Adams (56 MS) & Lillie (55 MS). Both said their 1st marriage occurred at age 20. Both her husband & father-in-law were proprietors of a transfer company; she was a bookkeeper at a transfer company. – On his WWII (1942) draft card, Charles Walter Adams lived at 233 S. Washington St., Yazoo City, Yazoo MS, with his wife, Mrs. Ora McAdams Adams. He worked at Union Producing Co., Shreveport, Caddo Parish LA. – Ora is buried in Visalia Public Cemetery, Visalia, Tulare CA. F: 148386362
- Era Lorene McAdams Hall, b. Aug 1896 TX according to the 1900 census but ca. 1898 (age 12 in 1910 census) or 13 Aug 1900 Dallas, Dallas TX on her Find A Grave record and ca. 1901 in the 1920 census – 28 Feb 1980 Marshall, Harrison TX. – Usually used her middle name Lorene (or some spelling variation of it). - She was age 3 in the 1900 census; her younger brother Charlie had a birthdate of Sep 1900, so the 13 Aug 1900 birthdate on Find A Grave is not possible. - As Lorine McAdams, married William Turner Hall (1933-1993, F: 117295386) on 1 Jun 1923 in Tyler Co. TX. - Resident of Marshall TX in Jun 1976 when brother James died. – Her TX death record lists her parents as John McAdams & Mary McDonald but other records list her death with parents Alexander P. McAdams & Mary A. Dickerson. - Buried in Hall’s Hill – Edgemont Cemetery, Marshall, Harrison TX. F: 117295435
- Charles Tower McAdams, 7 Sep 1900 TX – 28 Nov 1981. On his WWI draft card (12 Sep 1918), listed as Charley McAdams, he resided in Atlanta, Cass TX, NOK his mother Mary & was farming for A.P. McAdams [his father]. Married 25 Dec 1926 in Columbia Co. AR to Maudie (“Jack”) Mills (1910-2006, F: 13111147). He was a resident of Tullos, LaSalle Parish LA & she a resident of Haynesville, Claiborne Parish LA. – Buried in Old Town Cemetery, Haynesville, Claiborne Parish LA. F: 11018404
- Marvin Mitchell McAdams, 2 Sep 1909 TX – 23 Oct 1983. SSN 455-07-1795. Often used the name Mitchell. Husband of Lois Davis McAdams (1912-1990, F: 48695372). Social Security reported his last residence was in Roxie, Franklin MS. Buried in Magnolia Cemetery, Winn Parish LA. F: 48695365
