Tragedy Near Cairo

Don McCracken was shot and killed by Irvin Connell at a beer garden known as the Half-Way house, four miles north of Cairo. What the difficulty was about has not developed. The two young men, in company with three girls from Cairo, and two other young men from Mound City, were drinking beer, when McCracken picked up a beer bottle and hurled it at Connell. It missed him and Connell drew his pistol and fired, the ball entering McCracken's stomach. McCracken was taken to Mound City about 11 o'clock, and died in a few minutes after being taken from the buggy. Connell arrived at Mound City about a half hour later and ~~surrendered to the authorities~~ and was placed in jail to await the action of the coroner's inquest. McCracken is the oldest son of Q. A. McCracken of Mound City, and Connell is a son of J. F. Connell of the Pulaski Enterprise.

Industrialist At Paoli Dies

Frank McCracken, prominent Paoli chair manufacturer, died at the Jewish Hospital in Louisville about 11:00 p.m. Saturday following a heart attack at his home last Friday morning.

Mr. McCracken was well-known in Southern Indiana and was president of the La-Or-Ma Shrine Club, which is composed of Lawrence, Orange and Martin county residents.

The body will lie in state at the Paoli Presbyterian Church from 12:00 noon to 2:00 p.m. Wednesday. Although a private funeral will be held for members of the family at the home at 10:00 a.m. Wednesday, a second funeral will be held for the benefit of friends at 2:00 p.m.

Rev. John Prentiss will officiate, and funeral arrangements are in charge of the Ellis Funeral Home at Paoli. Burial will be at the Paoli Community Cemetery.

Mr. McCracken was born in Illinois on April 16, 1887. His parents were Quincey A. and Mattie Elizabeth Theet McCracken. Surviving the deceased are his widow and two sons, Richard and Donald, of Paoli.

In addition to the affiliations already mentioned, Mr. McCracken was a member of the Presbyterian Church, the Kiwanis Club, the Meridian Club and the Masonic Blue Lodge at Paoli.
