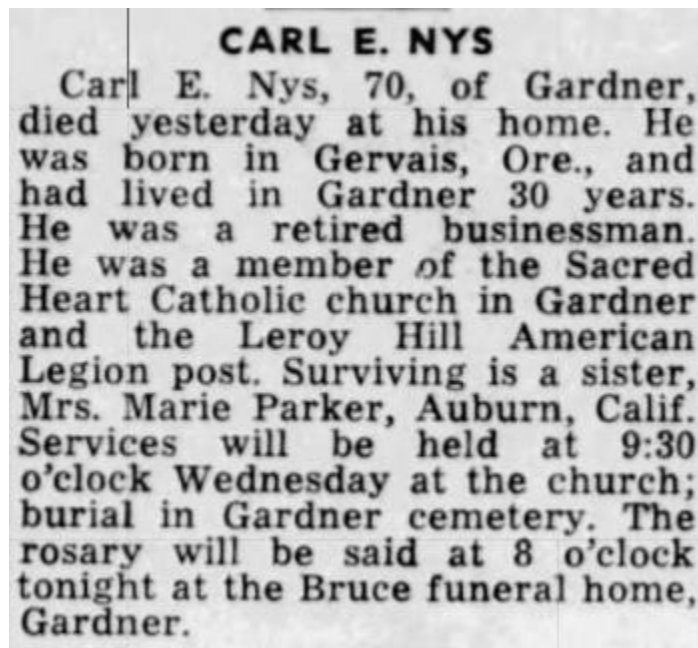

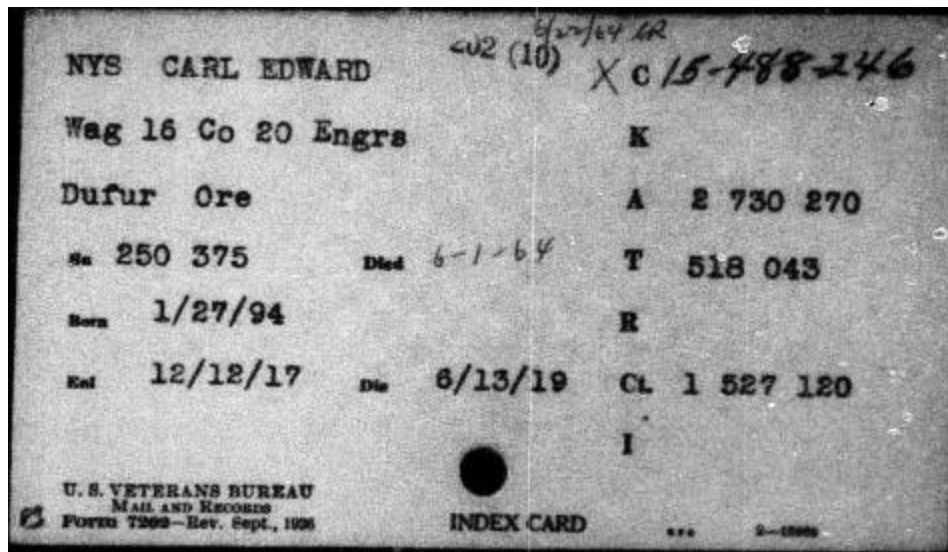

Nys Funeral to Be Monday; Dies From Infection

Funeral services for Bernard Nys, former Gervais farmer who died in a Portland hospital Friday, as the result of blood poisoning, will be held from Gervais Monday with the Catholic church in charge. Further arrangements have not been completed.

Mr. Nys was born near Gervais and lived in that district for 40 years. Thereafter he moved to eastern Oregon and finally to McMinnville where he had lived in recent years.

Among those surviving are a sister, Mrs. Carrie Fisher of Salem and a brother, living on French prairie.

Besides Curtis Willson and Archie D. Roberts, two Salem men known to have been aboard the transport Tuscania, which was torpedoed Tuesday off the coast of Ireland, information comes that other men of this section of the state were aboard the ship and their safety is yet in doubt.

Carl Nys, son of Mr. and Mrs. Bernard Nys who live near Gervais, was on the ship. Other Marion county men were Leonard D. Wolfard of Silverton and Roy E. Powelson of Mill City. Edgar J. Seeley of Independence is added to the Polk county list.

Everett Hale, who was with a Wisconsin unit, is a brother of Miss Beatrice Hale, a teacher in the Washington junior high school.

Carl E. Nys of Company D, Sixth battalion, Twentieth engineers, who is among the survivors of the torpedoed Tuscania, is a cousin of Miss Golda Goulet, stenographer in the office of Robert Warrack, inspector of the Seventeenth lighthouse district. The only word relatives have received is through press dispatches and as he is reported in a hospital on the Irish coast, they are anxious to learn of his condition. Nys was a resident of near Grass Valley. His grandfather was the late L. H. Poujade of Gervais, Or., an old Oregon pioneer, and who was justice of the peace at Gervais for years.

In another cablegram received by Mr. and Mrs. Bliem at Dufur, their son, Louis C. Bliem, who was also aboard the Tuscania, has been unable to leave the hospital.
